Decision of ISU Disciplinary Commission

On April 26, 2013, the ISU filed a complaint against Mr. Hyung-Joon Joo, a Speed Skater from the Republic of Korea, for an alleged ISU Anti-Doping Rule violation.

Following consideration of the alleged ISU Anti-Doping Rule violation, the ISU Disciplinary Commission has, on August 19, 2013 taken the following decision:

“Decision

- 1. Hyung-Joon JOO is declared responsible for an Anti-Doping violation, committed on March 22, 2013 at the Essent ISU World Single Distances Speed Skating Championships 2013 in Sochi.*
- 2. Hyung-Joon JOO is reprimanded and warned to not engage in similar conduct in the future, which conduct will cause a more severe action.*
- 3. Hyung-Joon JOO’s competitive result (21st rank) obtained on March 22, 2013 at the Essent ISU World Single Distances Speed Skating Championships 2013 is disqualified with all the resulting consequences including forfeiture of any medals, points and prizes.*
- 4. Korea Skating Union has to reimburse the ISU for the costs of these proceedings.*
- 5. The skater bears his own costs.”*

The decision of the Disciplinary Commission is published in full on the ISU website.

This decision is subject to appeal to the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS), as per Article 24 Paragraph 12 and Article 25 of the ISU Constitution 2012.
