



## **03/10/2017 – Single Skating Flying Spin and Spin with Flying Entry**

**2017/2018 Record of Clarification from Sport Director and Technical Committee**

### **QUESTION:**

**If in a Flying Spin or Spin with Flying entry with change of foot there are not three revolutions on the first foot, the short part of the spin is ignored including any features and the Spin has no change of foot.**

- 1. Can this spin with no change of foot still have four features called if successfully performed?**
- 2. Can the feature all three positions on the second foot be used in the above case?**
- 3. Does this rule apply to both Short and Free Skating?**

### **ANSWER:**

- 1. Yes, this will be considered as a spin on one foot with the possibility to have all 4 features on one foot.**
- 2. No, being considered a spin without change of foot this feature cannot be awarded**
- 3. No just to the Free Skating, in Short Program the result will be Flying Spin No Value**
