2017/2018 Record of Clarification from Sport Director and Technical Committee

QUESTION:

In Any Spin with change of foot if there are not three revolutions on the first foot, the short part of the spin is ignored including any features and the Spin has no change of foot.

1. Can this spin with no change of foot still have four features called if successfully performed?
2. Can the feature all three positions on the second foot be used in the above case?
3. Does this rule apply to both Short and Free Skating?
4. If in such a spin the skater changes foot a second time performing more than 3 revs after the first and second change how do we call this spin and award features?

ANSWER:

1. Yes, this will be considered as a spin on one foot with the possibility to have all 4 features on one foot.
2. No, being considered a spin without change of foot this feature cannot be awarded
3. No just to the Free Skating, in Short Program the result will be not required spin and consequently No Value
4. We will ignore the part of the spin with less than 3 revs and the first change of foot. The spin will be considered as a change of foot spin (combo or in one position) and two features on each foot can be awarded.
