Media Accreditation Information

All media must apply for media accreditation through the ISU online media accreditation system on the International Skating Union (ISU) website (www.isu.org) under «Media Accreditation». Alternatively click [here](#) to get direct access.

Only professional journalists, editors and photographers operating for editorial purpose, or producing an item containing informative content, will be accredited. Editorial use implies use by a media organization, including: agencies, newspapers, magazines, TV, radio, Internet, and/or an extension within an existing multimedia company (newspaper, magazine, TV, agency), as well as representatives from ISU Member federations acting as media for their press and communication activities. Informative content implies editing of original information.

The deadline to apply for media accreditation is **October 13, 2017**. All media must provide the following documentation when applying for media accreditation and further information could be requested:

1. Copy of current professional media or journalist card
2. ID photo in .jpg.
3. *If not in possession of a professional media card, a comment must be added to the note box provided and a letter from your editor confirming your assignment must be uploaded to your application.*

Accreditation will be granted to professional journalists and photographers only.

Writing Press (newspaper, magazine, internet, agencies and ISU Member Federations): maximum two professionals per organization

Photographer: maximum one professional per organization (agencies and major newspapers: maximum two professionals)

Television non-right holder: maximum three professionals per organization

Radio non-right holder: maximum one professional per organization

Freelancer: A freelance journalist or photographer is a full time professional editor or photographer, who is not employed by an agency or newspaper – a self-employed professional. A freelance editor or photographer must provide written evidence that he/she operates on behalf of a clearly identified media. A freelance editor or photographer operating under his/her own account will not be accepted.

The total number of accredited media representatives will be subject to space available. The Organizing Committee (OC) and ISU reserve the right to refuse accreditation should the number of applications exceed given space or if any requested information / documentation has not been provided in due time.

Rights holding TV and radio must also apply for accreditation via the ISU online media accreditation system. Access to the Right Holders area is restricted, therefore Right Holders are invited to contact the ISU Media Team media@isu.ch in order to obtain a username and password. Accreditation Confirmation

If the accreditation request is accepted, an automatic email of confirmation will be issued. You may be asked to present a copy of the confirmation email to receive your accreditation badge.

You will also be notified if your accreditation request is denied. Please note that the ISU and OC reserve the right to refuse accreditation with or without justification.

Transportation & Telecommunications

Public Transportation

- Moscow offers a comprehensive public transportation network including metro (subway), buses, trolleybuses and trams.
- Metro and ground transportation options use the same two types of tickets: universal (valid for any type of transportation, 1 ride – **55 RUR** or combined (any number of transfers between different transportation means within 90 minutes, 1 ticket – **65 RUR**. Information and prices for different ticket options can be found at the metro website available in English: <http://troika.mos.ru/en/tariffs/table/>, along with the metro system map.
- Sport Palace “Megasport” can be reached by bus number 818 from metro station “Dynamo” fourth stop – “Sports Palace “Megasport”
- All Moscow airports can be reached from the center of the city by Aeroexpress train. Trains for Sheremetyevo Airport leave every 30 minutes from Belorussky Train Station (located at “Belorusskaya” green-line and brown-line metro stations), travel time is 30 minutes. Trains for Domodedovo airport leave every 30 minutes from Paveletsky Train Station (located at “Paveletskaya” green-line and brown-line metro stations), travel time is 45 minutes. Trains for Vnukovo airport leave every 60 minutes from Kievsky Train Station (located at “Kievskaya” blue-line, light blue-line and brown-line stations), travel time is 35 minutes. One-way Aeroexpress ticket costs **500 RUR**, service is not available during the night time (12.30 am – 6 am). Further information can be found on the website <http://aeroexpress.ru/en/> (available in English and Russian).
- There is no unified Taxi carrier in Moscow. Taxi services are effected by different companies, their vehicles may have different color and appearance and different rates. If you need to use a taxi, we strongly advise you to ask the hotel reception to order a car for you.

Telecommunications

Facilities offered to the media at the Media Center:

- Tables equipped with power supply (two power 220V sockets for each work place)
- Free cable internet connectivity (2 048 kbit/s)
- Free Wi-Fi internet access (802.11g, 2,4GHz, WPA password protection)
- CATV monitors (at the Media Center and Mixed Zone)
- Statistical monitors (at the Media Center and Mixed Zone)

The electric current is 220 Volts (50 Hz) and the plugs used are two round pins.

Mobile Phone Network:

There are three major mobile network providers in Russia: MTS, Beeline, and Megafon. The primary mobile phone standard is GSM-900 and GSM – 1800. Prices, coverage, and services offered by the operators are quite similar.

Currency:

The exchange rate of Ruble to US Dollar is approximately **60** Rubles for **1** Dollar and **70** Rubles for **1** Euro. The rate is set by the Central Bank of Russia and usually varies little every day. Money can be changed at any bank and at most hotel reception desks.

The following coins and banknotes are in use in Russia today:

5000, 1000, 500, 100, 50, and 10 Rubles notes

10, 5, 2, and 1 Ruble coins

50, 10, 5, and 1 Kopeck coins
