



## ISU TESTING POOLS CRITERIA

---

The following criteria determine the Skaters listed in the ISU Testing Pools, either Registered Testing Pool (RTP) or ISU Testing Pool (TP).

### **Figure Skating**

#### **ISU Testing Pool (TP)**

For both ladies and men skaters ranked in each discipline of Figure Skating (singles Men and Ladies, Pairs and Ice Dance):

- In the top 3 of the previous season's World Figure Skating Championships
- In the top 2 of the previous season's World Junior Figure Skating Championships.

### **Speed Skating**

#### **ISU Registered Testing Pool (RTP)**

For both ladies and men skaters ranked:

- In the top 8 in the previous season's World Allround Championships
- In the top 8 in the previous season's World Sprint Championships
- In the top 3 of each distance from the previous season's World Single Distances Championships
- In the top 3 of each distance from the previous season's Final Classification World Cup.

#### **ISU Testing Pool (TP)**

For both ladies and men skaters ranked:

- 9 to 15 in the previous season's World Allround Championships
- 9 to 15 in the previous season's World Sprint Championships
- 4 to 5 of each distance from the previous season's World Single Distances Championships
- 4 to 5 of each distance from the previous season's Final Classification World Cup
- In the top 5 in the previous season's World Junior Championships

### **Short Track Speed Skating**

#### **ISU Registered Testing Pool (RTP)**

For both ladies and men skaters ranked:

- In the top 8 in the previous season's World Short Track Speed Skating Championships
- In the top 3 of each distance from the previous season's Final Classification World Cup

#### **ISU Testing Pool (TP)**

For both ladies and men skaters ranked:

- 9 to 15 in the previous season's World Short Track Speed Skating Championships
- 4 to 5 of each distance from the previous season's Final Classification World Cup
- In the top 5 in the previous season's World Short Track Junior Championships

Additional Skaters may be added in any ISU Testing Pools by the ISU based on Testing results (urine and/or blood), and performance.

A Skater who is retiring from competitions will be removed from any ISU Testing Pool following official announcement by his/her Member.

Additionally any Skater who is not on the above list but may be entered for a major Event (World Championships, Olympic Winter Games) may also be included in any ISU Testing Pools.

The ISU Testing Pools will be reviewed periodically and modified if necessary based on performance and/or Testing results (urine and/or blood).
