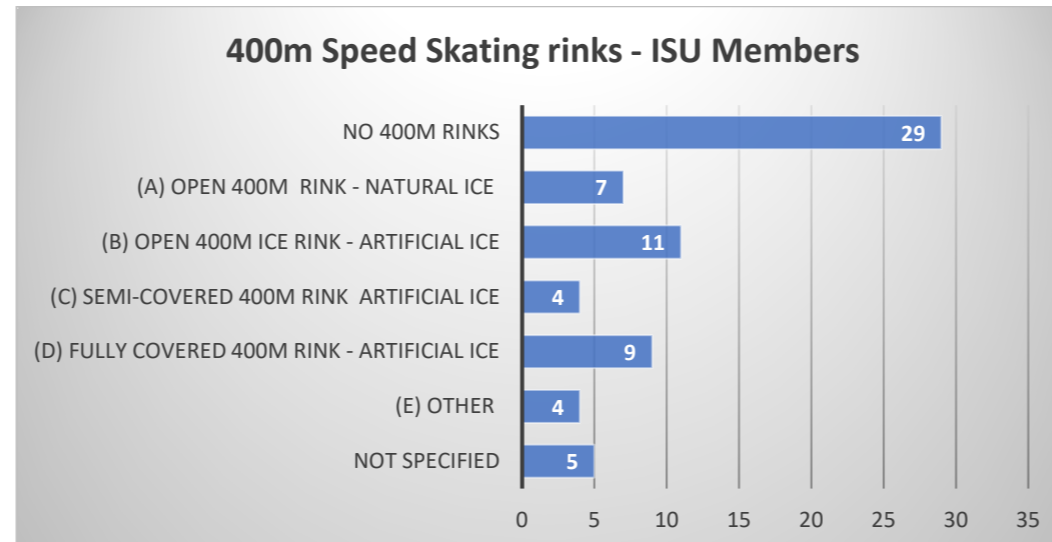


Development Program Survey 2020 – Summary

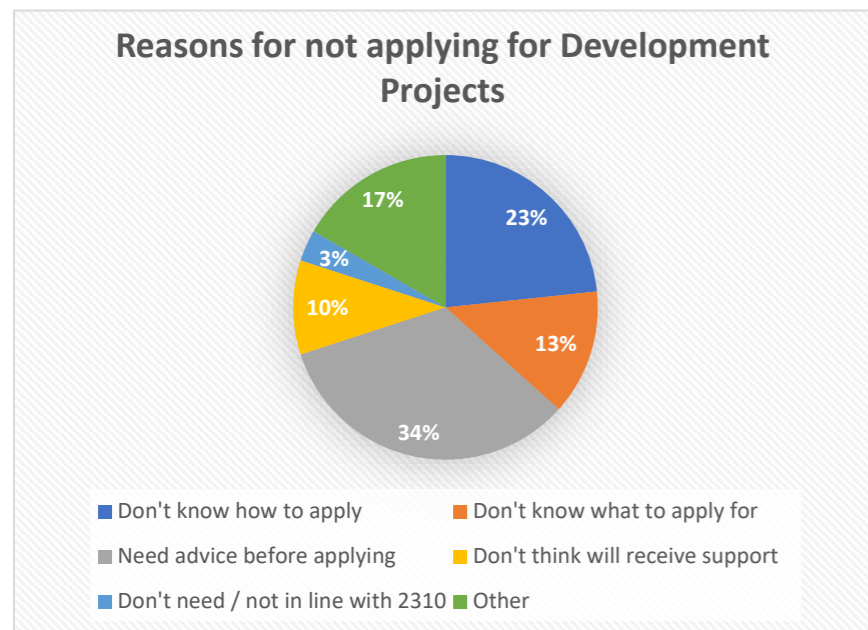

The Development Commission will:

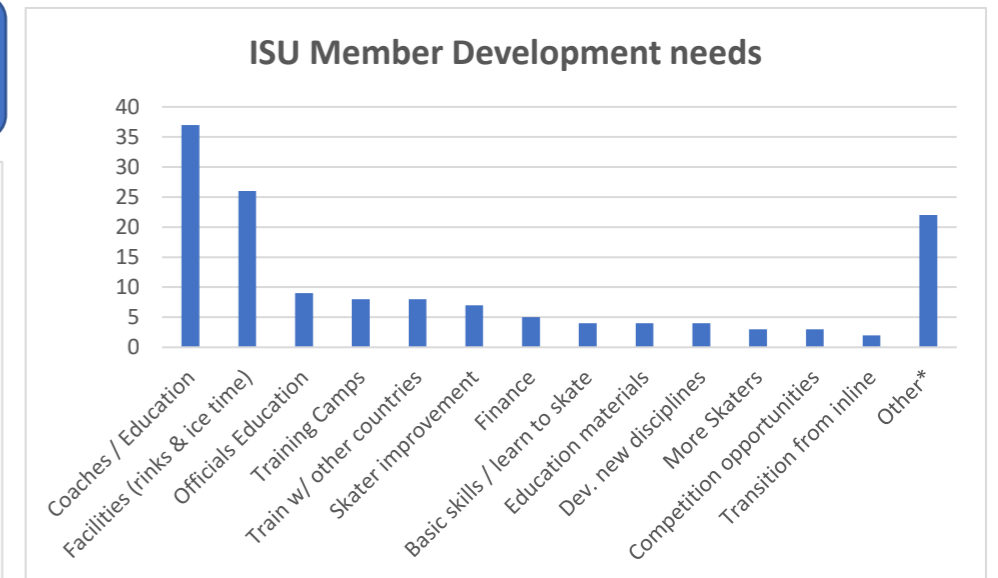
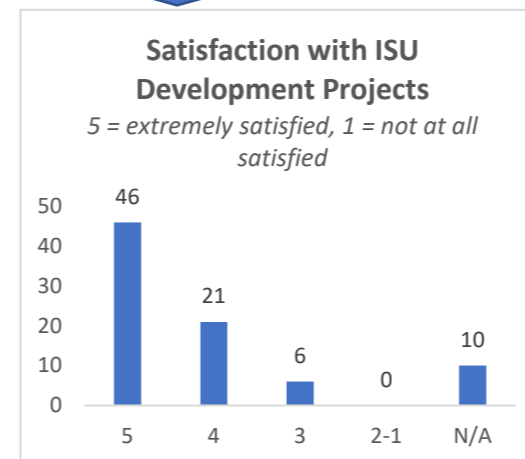
- ✦ Continue to focus on projects giving ISU Members access to 400m ovals

- ✦ Encourage ISU Members who have never or seldom applied for Development Projects to be proactive in contacting the DVC for advice and information
- ✦ be proactive in contacting ISU Members that need development help but are not requesting it
- ✦ Provide a summary on the ISU website of the available support and initiatives, along with a calendar of the initiatives

73 ISU Members said that they had been involved in Development Projects



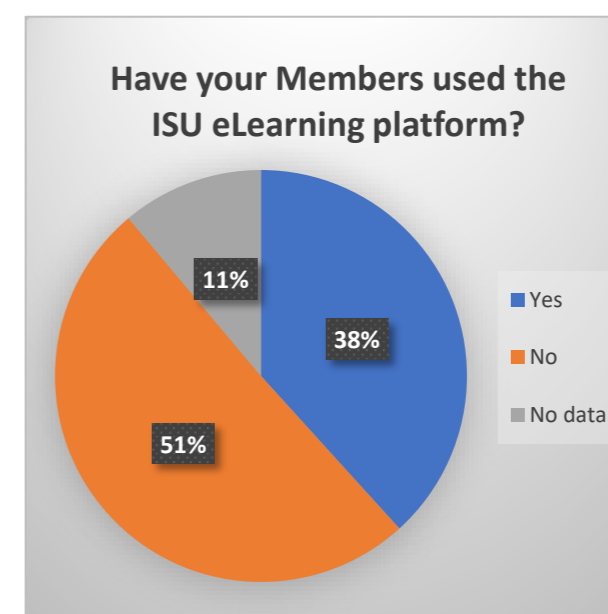
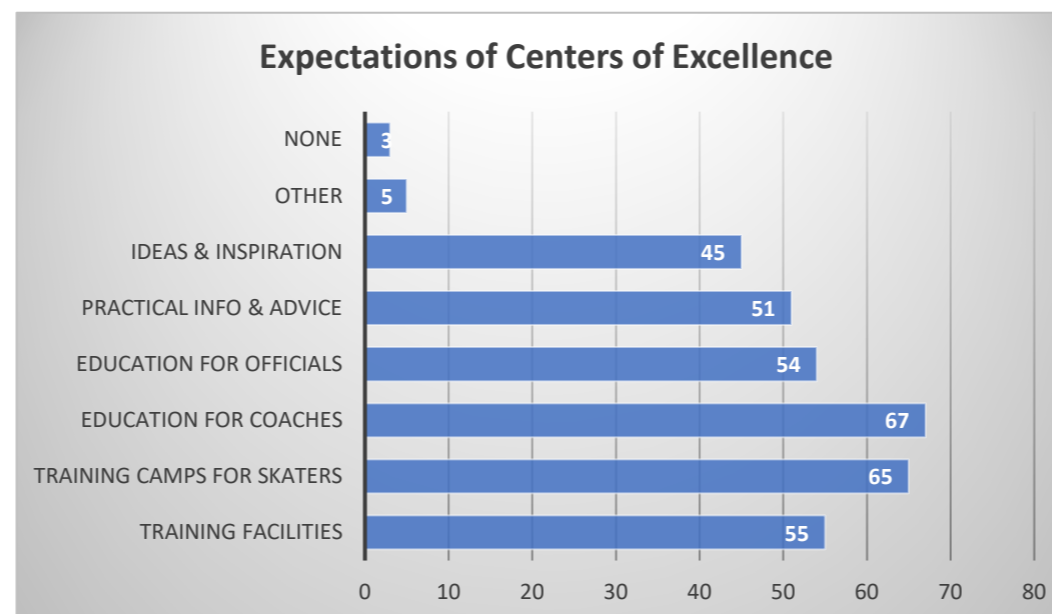
The Development Commission will:
