General

The goal of the seminar is to develop pair skating knowledge, in particular for the new Junior & Senior pairs and to the possibility of forming new pairs skating in new countries where this discipline is not so well known.

Focus will be on training techniques and tools that could be utilized to foster the development of competitive pair skaters.

Seminar dates

April 27 - May 02, 2024 (Arrival: 26th of April – Departure: 3rd of May)

Target Group

Pairs eligible to participate:

- Junior & Senior Pairs
- Coaches

The number of Pairs and Coaches entered from each ISU Member is limited to:

- one pair per Nation (OC reserves the right to enter two pairs)

If there are more applications than the 12 available places, the OC will use the following selection criteria:

- priority to Junior Pairs

If there are fewer applications than the 12 available places, the OC will use the following selection criteria:

- Nations will be allowed to participate with more pairs

The seminar is also open to coaches who wish to participate without a pair in attendance: Additional coaches, even without pairs of skaters to follow, are invited to participate at their own expense in order to better develop their skills in pairs skating (both the technical and artistic elements) with the opportunity to connect themselves with experts.

The seminar is also open to Officials.

Skaters without a partner cannot be accepted to attend the Seminar.

The Seminar will be conducted in English.







Focus of this Seminar

The Seminar will aim to:

- better develop the elements of pair skating and training techniques both on and off-ice with world-class coaches and world-class senior pairs as demonstrators
- enhance physical health with specific off-ice training including ballet, lifts, relaxation and stretching with the support of world-renowned coaches and dance mentors
- improve the basics of the components through music lessons and study of the program criteria with the support of a music master and ISU components moderator.
- Improve skating skills (focus on glide, expression, flow, balance, variety of edge and turns)

The seminar will be moderated by world-class coaches from different countries, professional dancers and music directors. World-class senior pairs skaters will also be involved as demonstrators.
