What sets this seminar apart from other pair seminars is the combination of technical content, as well as artistic and mental and nutrition aspects for athletes and their coaches combined with the specific preparation of officials for higher qualifications as they enter their last study phase before taking exams.

Through working together and exchanging ideas and opinions on certain elements it gives the officials the opportunity to get involved in the teams' element development process while gaining more knowledge about the practical training process which will help them in their work with pair skating teams in their member federations as well as for their work on the panels.

Content

Athletes have a chance to receive valuable technical and artistic input as well as feedback on their elements and programs early in the season which they can implement in their work at home.

Sessions will include

- * On- and Off-Ice Technical sessions and Skating Skills for pairs with competition experience and their coaches
- * Off-Ice ice dance classes focusing on partner movements, oneness and unison
- * Level Check of elements
- Monitoring event with feedback from the Technical Panel and ISU judges on technical elements and Program Components
- Sportpsychology sessions on mental training strategies and teambuilding for pair teams that will help skaters to develop conflict resolution strategies during training and competition as well as the creation of a team identity.
- Session on nutrition for athletes and coaches. Different needs according to athletes age and development phase with the specific aspects of different phases throughout the season (competition season and off-season).
- * Seminar sessions for coaches and athletes on Levels and Program Components
- * Seminar sessions for Coaches on LTAD and technical demands in different age groups as well as safe sport aspects specific for coaching pair skating teams

Especially officials (TS, TC, judges) from countries that don't have pair teams of their own will be able to connect with experienced professionals and gain deeper insight into the discipline of pair skating.

Sessions will include

- * Seminar on current rules and changes with practical sessions on- and off-ice together with the pair teams
- * Preparation for qualification examinations

- * Level check of teams' elements
- * Monitoring event as practice event including feedback and joint discussion
- * Off-ice lift class + demonstration of lift groups and holds
- * Joint discussion between TS, TC, coaches and skaters (Junior and Senior Level) about levels of difficulty with examples
- * Sportpsychology session on giving respectful feedback as well as safe sport aspects for officials.

Registration

Registration fee is 150 EUR per person This fee includes all on- and off-ice as well as seminar sessions and lunch and dinner on all practice days.

Payment deadline will be April 24, 2024.

Athletes, coaches and officials will be responsible for all travel expenses, and for the living expenses from beginning till the end of the seminar.

Arrival date for athletes and coaches: Sunday, June 30, 2024 (Start of the seminar July 1, 2024, morning)

Arrival date officials: Wednesday, June 2, 2024 (Start of the seminar July 3, 2024, morning) Departure date for everyone: Sunday, July 7, 2024, afternoon.
