The Italian Figure Skating Federation (Federazione Italiana Sport del Ghiaccio) and the Figure Skating Club Young Goose Academy is pleasured to origanize the Egna Spring Trophy in Egna/Neumarkt, Italy.

1. GENERAL INFORMATION:

The EGNA SPRING TROPHY will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2018, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules for Figure Skating as well as pertinent ISU Communications.

Participation in the EGNA SPRING TROPHY is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member, Rule 109, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 b) and c) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of it. In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2030 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must to be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

2.1 PLACE OF THE COMPETITION

Icerink: WürthArena: Via Brennero 7, Egna (BZ) ITALY, heated and indoor ice rink 30m x 60m, bar and restaurant inside the arena.

Technical Requirements are in accordance with ISU Technical Rules - Single and Pair Skating 2018 and respective ISU Communications. Short Program: 2 min 40 sec, +/- 10 sec Free Skating: 4 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec





SENIOR PAIR SKATING

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2018, Rule 620, paragraphs 1 and 2 for 2017/18. Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/- 10 sec.

JUNIOR LADIES

Technical Requirements are in accordance with ISU Technical Rules - Single and Pair Skating 2018 and respective ISU Communications. Short Program: 2 min 40 sec, +/- 10 sec Free Skating: 3 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

JUNIOR MEN

Technical Requirements are in accordance with ISU Technical Rules - Single and Pair Skating 2018 and respective ISU Communications. Short Program: 2 min 40 sec, +/- 10 sec Free Skating: 4 min, +/- 10 sec

JUNIOR PAIR SKATING

Short Program

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2018, Rule 620. Duration: 2 min., 40 sec., +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Figure Skating & Pairs Skating 2018, Rule 621 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value. Duration: 4 min., +/- 10 sec.

ADVANCED NOVICE GIRLS

Age and requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2018, ISU Communication 2024 and all respective ISU Communications. Short Program: Max 2 min 20 sec, +/- 10sec Free Skating: 3 min +/-10 sec

ADVANCED NOVICE BOYS

Age and requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2018, ISU Communication 2024 and all respective ISU Communications. Short Program: Max 2 min 20 sec, +/-10sec Free Skating: 3 min 30 sec, +/-10 sec





ADVANCED NOVICE PAIRS

Short Program

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2018 and the respective ISU Communication. Duration: 2 min., 20 sec., +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Figure Skating & Pairs Skating 2018, Rule 621 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value. Duration: 3 min., 30 sec., +/- 10 sec.

INTERMIDIATE NOVICE BOYS AND GIRLS

Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2018, ISU Communication 2172 and all respective ISU Communications. Free Skating: Duration: 3 min, +\- 10 sec

BASIC NOVICE BOYS AND GIRLS

Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2018, ISU Communication 2172 and all respective ISU Communications. Free Skating: Duration: 2 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

3. ENTRIES

3.1 ATHLETES

Competitors must be entered through their respective Member Federation and by sending an email to egna.spring.trophy@gmail.com. <u>The official entry form has to be used and skaters must send to the OC a</u> copy of their passport and PPC document at the time of entries, as well as ISU Clearence Certificate if applicable. The lack of one of these documents makes it an invalid registration. The entries for interclub categories (Basic Novice and Intermediate Novice) are limited to 40 participants. Depending on the number of participants the organization will decide whether or not to accept extra entries.

Please note that the organizer may divide categories with too many entries into subgroups.

Entries must reach the Event Organizer not later than March 10th, 2019.

Entry Forms, Program Content Sheet and additional forms can be downloaded from ISU website.





3.2 JUDGES

Each participating ISU member may nominate one (1) International or ISU Judge, not later than March 10th, 2019. The Panels will be drawn immediately after the closing of entries. The members concerned will be notified of the result of the draw. Each panel of Judges in Seniors, Juniors, Advanced Novices and Novices Basic categories will consist of 5 Judges.

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for rooms and meals for all Referees, the Technical Controllers, the Technical Specialist, the Data and Replay Operators.

The Organizing Committee will cover the costs for travel expenses only for Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialist, Data and Replay Operators.

4. CANCELLATION

Cancellation of the competitor entry, has to be done till **March 21st**, **2019**. For any later cancellation the team leader of respective Federation will be asked to pay the entry fee.

5. ENTRY FEE

Seniors, Junior and Advanced Novice 80 Euro per skater Basic Novice and Intermediate Novice 65 Euro per skater

Pairs 120 Euro (60 Euro per skater)

Payment shall be made by bank transfer or on the spot at the office of the Organizing Committee in the WürthArena during the accreditation.

6. RESULTS

Results for all categories will be calculated using the new ISU Judging System. The result and any additional information for the event will be published on the websites www.fisg.it, www.isu.org.

7. MUSIC

Music has to be sent in file .mp3 to egna.spring.trophy@gmail.com. All files must show the competitor's name, the nation and the exact running time of the music. Each program (short program, free skating) must be saved in a separate file.





8. LIABILITY

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection by Competitors and Officials. In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the 2019 Egna Dance Trophy to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must be assure full medical attendance and also the return to home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

9. ACCREDITATION

Accreditation will take place at the Wuertharena ice rink. The accreditation desk will be open starting Wednesday, March 27, 2019 from 5.30 pm to 7.30 pm. All persons to be accredited are kindly asked to accredit upon arrival. Accreditation will be given to Officials and ISU Office Holders. Accreditation as a team member will be given to all drawn judges, competitors, one coach per competitor, and one chaperone per competitor.

10. DRAW

<u>The opening draw for the order of skating will be held on Wednesday, March 27 at 6.30 pm</u> <u>at the Bar Bistrot Würtharena.</u>

No draw after short programs. Starting order for free programs will be according the reverse of the results of short programs.

11. ADDITIONAL PRACTICE

Rates for additional practice hours are as follow: 25 minutes practice together with other skaters – 10 €per skater

12. AWARDING CEREMONY

Just first three places will be awarded with victory ceremony
