FIRST INFORMATION

After hosting the Olympic Games in 2006, the ISU Grand Prix of Figure Skating Final in 2007 and the ISU World Figure Skating Championships[®] in 2010, the city of Torino is glad to welcome another major international figure skating event such as the ISU Grand Prix of Figure Skating[®] Final 2019/20.

It is an honor to once again invite the Skating Family to join us in our beautiful country and we hope you will have a chance to experience some of the beauty of the Host City.

LOCATION

THE CITY

Torino is the Capital of the Piemonte region and it sits on the banks of the longest Italian river, the Po, in the north-west of Italy, surrounded by the Alps and the Superga Hill.

The city has a rich culture and history, but it is also known for its elegant architecture, fine food and historical monuments; contended by Italy and France, it was very prominent during the Renaissance and it was proclaimed the very first Capital of the Italian Kingdom, from 1861 until 1865. Also among the leaders of the Industrial Revolution, Turin was home to Italy's first automobile industries such as Fiat and Lancia, but also of many textile and mechanical factories.

CLIMATE

The climate is moderately continental, with cold, damp winters and hot, muggy summers. The city is located at 250 meters (800 feet) above sea level, at the foot of the Alps.

Because of its position, in summer it is not as hot as the rest of the Po valley, while in winter, it is a little less foggy.

VENUE

PALAVELA Via Ventimiglia 145, 10127 Torino – TO Italy

Palavela, formerly known as Palazzo delle Mostre and Palazzo a Vela, is an indoor arena that is located within the city of Turin, on the bank of the River Po. It was designed by engineer Franco Levi and architects Annibale and Giorgio Rigotti. It was originally built for the Italia '61 Expo and the name comes from its distinctive roof which is in the shape of a 'Sail', 'Vela' in Italian.

It was renovated in 2002 in preparation for hosting the Figure Skating and Short Track events of the 2006 Winter Olympic Games.

The new design, by renowned Italian architect Gae Aulenti, featured two different structures, the Iconic original Sail Roof and the Arena Building sitting right underneath it; it preserved its true nature while transforming it into a state-of-the-art facility capable of hosting many different kinds of events.

GENERAL ACCOMODATION INFORMATION

All reservations must be made through the Organizing Committee via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS). Individual reservations by Team Members at the Official Hotels will not be accepted.

ROOM COSTS

The Organizing ISU Member will pay accommodation and meal expenses for all Skaters, Referees, Technical Specialists, Technical Controllers, Judges and Data & Replay Operators from dinner on the day preceding the first official practice through breakfast on the day after the Exhibition, in accordance with the ISU Grand Prix of Figure Skating Announcement 2019-20, item 9.11.

As a general rule, skaters of the same gender from the same federation will share rooms with two beds. Should skaters choose to stay in single rooms (<u>subject to availability</u>) the member federation will have to pay the charges for the extra room(s).

RESERVATION POLICY AND PROCEDURES

The Organizing Committee will get in touch with ISU Member Federations after the conclusion of the last ISU Junior Grand Prix Event, to start planning travel arrangements and accommodations.

The OC will send an invoice of the total due by each ISU Member Federation after the conclusion of the last ISU Grand Prix Event confirming the room costs not covered by the OC.

ACCOMPANYING PERSON

Team members whose accommodation is not covered by the Organizing Committee who share a room with a team member whose accommodation is paid by the OC will be charged 50% of the room rate.

EXTRA SERVICES. INCIDENTALS AND DAMAGES

A credit card will be required upon check-in to cover incidentals as well as a security deposit. Incidental services such as external telephone, pay TV, room service, mini-bar or laundry will be blocked for all Team Members (including Athletes) if a personal credit card is not presented at the hotel front desk upon check-in. Payment for incidental services is the guest's responsibility and should be settled directly with the hotel at check-out. Each ISU Member is responsible for all unpaid incidentals and damages.

There will be no dinner in the Dining Room on Sunday, December 8th, since the Closing Banquet will take place.

BANQUET

Special invitations for the Closing Banquet will be issued at registration and should then be exchanged for tickets by Thursday December 5th in the OC Office (Hotel Concord, Po Room). A limited number of Closing Banquet tickets will be available for purchase only until Thursday December 5th in the OC Office, for those who are not entitled to a complimentary ticket, as well as Chaperones of the Competitors. If Closing Banquet invitations or tickets are lost, new tickets must be purchased at the user's own expense.

ACCREDITATION

Accreditations for all ISU Event Officials, ISU Office Holders, ISU Guests, Judges and confirmed team delegation members will be given at the athletes Hotel Concord on Monday and Tuesday in the 'Stupinigi' Room, on the first floor. One accreditation point will be available for late arrivals in room 'Po' from Wednesday and throughout the week. Accreditations will also be available at Palavela from Wednesday on with exact hours to be confirmed.

You will be required to present a valid passport (and clearance certificate, if applicable) prior to receiving accreditation. Accreditation will not be issued without presentation of a valid passport.

Forgotten, lost or stolen accreditation cards must be reported immediately and can only be replaced for a cash fee of Euro 150. The replacement is upon approval of the ISU and the OC.

TRAVEL INFORMATION

ARRIVAL

The OC will provide transportation from the **international Turin Airport Caselle (TRN)** to the official Hotel starting on Monday December 2nd, 2019.

Torino Porta Nuova Station is located less then 200 m. from the Official Hotels, should any team member decide to arrive by train; while this is **not** an official arriving point, dates and time of arrival should be provided to the OC. Team Members (Skaters, Team Leaders, Team Officials), Event Officials, ISU Guests, ISU Office Holders and Member Presidents will be met by the OC at their arriving Terminal and directed to their transportation. Please provide the OC with the appropriate travel details in ORS. Once you have claimed your baggage please look for an OC Representative.

Transportation will also be made available for Coaches, Chaperones and Medical Staff if they are travelling with the Team and have provided all travel details in the ORS. If Coaches, Chaperones and Medical Staff are not travelling with the Team and request transportation, they will be charged € 65.

Should any guest's arrival be delayed for any reason, they are asked to inform the OC as soon as possible with the expected arrival time so that transportation arrangements can be modified. You may do so by contacting the Transportation Office. Please inform the OC of any changes to your travel plans or for any inquiries about transportation at any time, email transportation@torino2019.com or call +39 346 4751744.

DEPARTURE

Transportation at the conclusion of the event for Team Members entitled to complimentary departure transportation to the airport will be managed by scheduled departure shuttles. Each entitled Team Member scheduled departure time will be available no later than 1 day prior to departure on the transportation desk at the Hotel Concord and on the ISU Event app. No changes in departure times will be allowed unless approved by the Organizing Committee. Team members who are not entitled to complimentary transportation may contact the Transportation Office to enquire about the possibility to arrange it at a 65 Euro fee.

EVENT SHUTTLES

There will be one shuttle bus line between the Hotels and the Palavela Venue, with a single pick-up point for all three Hotels (less than 100 m. distance from each other). An accreditation card or bus permit must be presented before boarding the shuttle bus. The Organizing Committee will place an Event information and Transportation desk in the ground floor lobby of the hotels with the latest information on transportation and all other event information.

TRAVEL EXPENSES

The OC is responsible for covering travel expenses for the return air-fare (economy airfare only) to Turin for all Competitors qualified for the ISU Grand Prix of Figure Skating[®] Final 2019/20 and ISU Junior Grand Prix of Figure Skating Final 2019/20 as well as judges from the country of the ISU Member they represent. Please note that travel expenses will only be provided for a simple return fare from one origin point to Turin and back to the same origin point. No airfares for open jaw or two one-way tickets will be covered by the organizer.

The OC will contact the respective ISU Members after the last ISU Junior Grand Prix event and after the last ISU Grand Prix event in order to make the flight arrangements. The tickets will be acquired by the respective ISU Member and the OC will reimburse the cost of the ticket after the receipt of an invoice. The approval of the airfare from the OC is required before issuing any flight ticket. The OC might agree to pay for one extra night at the official Hotel should it be overall more convenient for an individual to postpone his return flight by one day.

VISA

Citizens from all countries will need a valid travel ID (passport or Schengen travel ID) and in some cases a visa to enter Italy. Please verify with the Embassy or Consulate of Italy in your country whether you need a Visa. You are encouraged to acquire information about obtaining a visa to enter Italy early in order to obtain it in time, expecially late entries for Senior participants.

CHAPERONES

Chaperones (a maximum of one per Skater) will not be accredited, but will receive a bus pass for the main delegation bus line and a practice ticket to be able to attend all practices in the main arena. Chaperones may pick up bus passes and practice tickets at the Organizing Committee Office located at the Hotel Concord. Photo ID will be required.

Each Chaperone must purchase either an individual or an all-event ticket at full face value to see the competitions either from the ticket office located in Palavela, or from the Event Website www.torino2019.com

USEFUL INFO

CREDIT CARDS

All major credit cards are accepted in Italy. Most hotels, shops, restaurants and taxi accept VISA and Master Card. American Express, Diners Club may not be accepted in all places.

TAXES

Taxes are included in the price presented to customers/guests in shops, hotels, restaurants, etc. As of July, 2017, the general sales tax (VAT) is 22%.

TIPPING

While tipping is not mandatory in Italy, it is customary in many circumstances for good service, especially in sit down restaurants, which offer table service.

ELECTRICITY

Electricity in Italy conforms to the European standard of 220V to 230V, with a frequency of 50Hz. Wall outlets typically accommodate plugs with two or three round pins (the latter grounded, the former not). The following plugs are used:
