# INTERNATIONAL FIGURE SKATING COMPETITION in Single skating for Advanced Novices and Juniors

INTERCLUB FIGURE SKATING COMPETITION for Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice and younger categories

#### 1. **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

The *Black Sea Ice Cup 2019* will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2018, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2018, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the *Black Sea Ice Cup 2019* is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2030 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must to be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

#### 2. TECHNICAL DATA:

#### 2.1 PLACE OF THE COMPETITION:

Black Sea Ice Arena, Kranevo, Bulgaria – an indoor ice-rink with ice surface of 60 x 30 m, air-conditioned and heated.



#### 2.2 CATEGORIES:

#### JUNIOR LADIES & MEN

Technical Requirements are in accordance with ISU Technical Rules - Single and Pair Skating 2018 and respective ISU Communication.

Short Program: 2 min 40 sec, +/- 10 sec

Free Skating: 3 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

#### **ADVANCED NOVICE GIRLS & BOYS**

Age and technical requirements are according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2018, ISU Communication 2242 and all respective ISU Communications.

Short Program: 2 min 20 sec, +/-10 sec

Free Skating: 3 min +/-10 sec

#### **INTERMEDIATE NOVICE GIRLS & BOYS**

Age and technical requirements are according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2018, ISU Communication 2242 and all respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: 3 min, +\- 10 sec

#### **BASIC NOVICE GIRLS & BOYS**

Age and technical requirements are according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2018, ISU Communication 2242 and all respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: 2 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

#### **CUBS GIRLS & BOYS**

Age requirements – Cubs is a skater who was born: 1.7.2009 – 30.6.2011

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

#### A well-balanced CUBS Free Skating Program must contain:

- a) Maximum of 4 jump elements for Girls and Boys, one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence consists of 2 (two) jumps of any number of revolutions, beginning with any jump, immediately followed by an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump to the take-off curve of the Axel jump. Triple jumps are not permitted. Any single or double jump (including Double Axel) cannot be executed more than twice in total.
- b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total) and one spin with no change of position and with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total). Flying entry is allowed.
- c) There must be a maximum:
- for Girls one (1) Choreographic sequence which includes at least one 3 seconds long spiral position. The sequence will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.
- for Boys maximum of one (1) step sequence with a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.

**Level explanation:** For CUBS, in all elements which are subject to levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not be counted for Level Requirements and will be

ignored by the Technical Panel.

The program components are judged according to the following criteria only:

- Skating Skills
- Performance

The factors for the program components are 2.5.

#### **CHICKS GIRLS & BOYS**

Age requirements - Chicks Skater is a girl who was born: 1.7.2011 and younger

Free Skating: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

#### A well-balanced CHICKS Free Skating Program must contain:

- a) Maximum of 4 jump elements for Girls and Boys, one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence consists of 2 (two) jumps of any number of revolutions, beginning with any jump, immediately followed by an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump to the take-off curve of the Axel jump. Triple jumps are not permitted. Any single or double jump (including Double Axel) cannot be executed more than twice in total.
- b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total) and one spin with no change of position and with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total). Flying entry is allowed.
- c) There must be a maximum:
- for Girls one (1) Choreographic sequence which includes at least one 3 seconds long spiral position. The sequence will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.
- for Boys maximum of one (1) step sequence with a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.

**Level explanation:** For CHICKS, in all elements which are subject to levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not be counted for Level Requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

The program components are judged according to the following criteria only:

- Skating Skills
- Performance

The factors for the program components are 2.5.

The same ISU rules on Judging, refereeing and work of the Technical Panel will be applied as it is in junior and senior international competitions.

#### 3. ENTRIES:

All ISU members and clubs, which are members of National Figure Skating Federations associated with ISU, are invited to take part at the competition.

Competitors from categories Juniors and Advanced Novices must be entered through their Member Federation.

Entries for Basic Novice, Intermediate Novice and younger categories will be accepted from Member Federations or clubs, which are members of National Figure Skating Federations, associated with the ISU

In case of too many entries, the organizer reserves the right to limit the number of participants.

Entry forms must reach the Event Organizer not later than September 5, 2019.

The organizer will not cover any expenses for competitors, team leaders, coaches or chaperons.

#### 4. CANCELLATION:

Cancellation of the competitor entry must be done till **September 13, 2019**. For any latter cancellation the team leader of respective Federation or Club will be asked to pay the entry fee.

#### 5. JUDGES:

Each participating ISU member may nominate one (1) International or ISU Judge. Nomination for Judge and substitute Judge must be sent along with the entry forms for competitors. The official entry form for Judges must reach the Organizing Committee, not later than **September 1, 2019**.

The Panels will be drawn immediately after the closing of entries. The members concerned will be notified of the result of the draw.

Each panel of Judges in Juniors and Advanced Novices categories will consist of 5 Judges. In young groups the panel of Judges will consist of 3 Judges.

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for rooms and meals for all Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialist, Data and Replay Operators and confirmed Judges at Therma Eco Village\*\*\*\*\*, beginning with dinner on Thursday, September 19, 2019 until lunch on Monday, September 23, 2019.

Travel expenses will be covered only for Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialist, Data and Replay Operators.

#### 6. ENTRY FEE:

For categories Juniors and Advanced Novices – €55 per skater.

For younger categories – €45 per skater.

Payment shall be made by bank transfer or on the spot in the office of the Organizing Committee in the Black Sea Ice Arena during the accreditation.

#### 7. *MUSIC:*

In accordance with Rule 343, paragraph 2, all Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on CD in any other approved format. All discs must show the Competition event, Competitor's name, the Nation and the exact running time of the music (not skating time) including

any starting signal and must be submitted at the time of registration. Each program (short program, free skating) must be recorded on a separate disc. In addition, competitors/couples must provide a back-up drive for each program.

#### 8. CALCULATION OF THE RESULTS:

Results for all categories will be calculated using the new ISU Judging System. The results and any additional information for the event you can find on <a href="icesportsvarna.com">icesportsvarna.com</a>

#### 9. PRESENTATION OF MEDALS AND PRIZES:

The three best placed Skaters in each event will be announced and honoured. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be presented to the medallists. All skaters will receive a diploma.

#### 10.LIABILITY:

According to ISU regulations, the Event Organizer accepts no liability for bodily harm, personal injury and loss of property or damages incurred by any competitor(s) or official(s).

#### 11.ACCREDITATION:

The accreditation will start on Wednesday, September 19, 2019 at 15:00h. in the office of the Organizing Committee at the Black Sea Ice Arena.

#### 12.DRAW:

The opening draw for the order of skating will be held on Wednesday, September 19, 2019.

The exact place and time will be published in the official detailed schedule.

Starting order for the free skating of categories Advanced Novices and Juniors will be in reverse order of the results of short program.

#### 13. ADDITIONAL PRACTICE:
