1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The **Icelab International Cup 2019** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2018, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2018, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation at **Icelab International Cup 2019** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2030 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

All competitors for Juniors Single & Pairs skating category must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation.

Short Program: 2 min 40 sec, +/- 10 sec

Free Skating: 4 min 00 sec, +/- 10 sec

JUNIOR LADIES, MEN & PAIRS

Technical Requirements are in accordance with ISU Technical Rules - Single and Pair Skating 2018 and respective ISU Communication.

Short Program: 2 min 40 sec, +/- 10 sec

Free Skating: 3 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

ADVANCED NOVICE GIRLS & BOYS

ADVANCED NOVICE PAIRS

Free Skating: 3 min +/-10 Sec

INTERMEDIATE NOVICE GIRLS & BOYS

Age and technical requirements are according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2018, ISU Communication 2242 and all respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: 3 min, +\- 10 sec

BASIC NOVICE GIRLS & BOYS

Age and technical requirements are according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2018, ISU Communication 2242 and all respective ISU Communications.

Free Skating: 2 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

CUBS GIRLS & BOYS

Age Requirements: Cubs is for skater who was born between 1/7/2009 and 30/06/2011

Free Skating: 2 min 10 sec, +/- 10 sec

A well-balanced CUBS Free Skating Program must contain:

- a) Maximum of 4 jump elements for Girls and Boys, one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. A jump sequence consists of 2 (two) jumps of any number of revolutions, beginning with any jump, immediately followed by an Axel type jump with a direct step from the landing curve of the first jump to the take-off curve of the Axel jump. Triple jumps are not permitted. Any single or double jump (including Double Axel) cannot be executed more than twice in total.
- b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total) and one spin with no change of position and with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total). Flying entry is allowed.
- c) There must be a maximum:
- for Girls one (1) Choreographic sequence which includes at least one 3 seconds long spiral position. The sequence will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.
- for Boys maximum of one (1) step sequence with a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.

Level explanation: For CUBS, in all elements which are subject to levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will not be counted for Level Requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

The program components are judged according to the following criteria only:

- Skating Skills
- Performance

The factors for the program components are 2.5

3. ENTRIES

3.1 Entries of Competitors

All ISU Members and clubs, which are member of National Figure Skating Federations associated with ISU, are invited to take part to the **Icelab International Cup 2019**.

Competitors from categories Junior Single & Pairs Skating must be entered through their Member Federation. Each participating ISU Member has the right to nominate two (2) competitors + one (1) substitute in each Junior category.

Entries for Advanced Novice Singles & pairs Skating, Intermediate Novice and Basic Novice and Cubs categories will be accepted from Member Federations or clubs, which are members of National Figure Skating Federations, associated with the ISU. Each participating ISU Member or club has the right to nominate two (2) competitors + one (1) substitute in each category.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right for all categories to accept entries that are over of the limit of the number of participant mentioned here above.

3.2.2 Entries of Judges

Each participating ISU Member has the right to nominate one (1) judge who has at least the qualification "Judge for International Competitions".

In case of too many nominated judges, the organizing committee will draw the panel of judges immediately after the closing date for the entries. The result of such draw will be communicated to all ISU Members involved in writing immediately after the conclusion of such draw.

3.3 Entry Fee

With the entry to the competition, the entry fee must be paid as follows:

75.00 €	per single skater for Junior and Advanced Novice
90.00 €	per pair for Senior, Junior and Advanced Novice
65.00 €	per single skater for Intermediate and Basic Novice
55.00 €	per single skater for Cubs

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason.

Entry fees must be paid after confirmation of member participation.

The Organizer will not return entry fee but you can replace one skater for another in any category not later than one week before draw.

In accordance with Rule 343, paragraph 2, all competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on CD in any other approved format. All discs must show the Competitor's name, The Nation and the exact running time of the music (not skating time) including any starting signal and must be submitted at the time of registration. Each program (short program, free skating) must be recorded a separate disc.
