## **Remote Media Accreditation**

**All media** must apply for remote media accreditation through the <u>ISU Online Media Accreditation</u> <u>System OMAS.</u>

In light of the current COVID-19 pandemic, the International Skating Union (ISU) and the Organizing Committee have been working diligently over the past few months to ensure there will be ample coverage opportunities available to media outlets wishing to cover the ISU events.

**Remote media accreditation holders** will not have access to the venue and will be covering the event virtually. Those holding a remote accreditation will not have access to the venue under any circumstances.

The deadline to apply for remote media accreditation is April 14, 2021.

All media must provide the following documentation when applying for media accreditation and further information can be requested.

- Endorsement Letter in .pdf, .jpg, .png or .jpeg (all media expect TV Right Holders and the Host Broadcaster)
- Copy of current professional media or journalist card in .pdf,.jpg,.png,.jpeg (all media)
- ID photo in .pdf, .jpg, .png or .jpeg (all media)

### **Accreditation Confirmation**

If the accreditation request is accepted, an email of confirmation will be issued.

You will also be notified if your accreditation request is denied. <u>Please note that the ISU and OC reserve the right to refuse accreditation with or without justification.</u>

### **Mixed Zone & Press Conference**

A virtual mixed zone (Zoom) will be in place as of April 15, to all media accreditation holders. All athletes will "come through" the mixed zone after receiving scores. All media accreditation holders will be able to tune in from their mobile device. A member of the Organizing Committee will moderate the virtual mixed zone. English and Russian translation will be available.

Virtual press conferences will take place at the end of each competition day and will feature the captain of the top-3 ranked teams and will be available virtually to all media accreditation holders. Press conferences will be moderated by a member of the Organizing Committee. English and Russian translation will be available.

All media accreditation holders will be able to access the mixed zone and press conference through a provided link.
