It is going to be nearly the same at the Olympic Games, because when you have World Team Trophy you have a lot of energy and you support each other. When you skate for your team, it gives you a lot of positive energy and for me every time this so important. After this competition, we should understand what we need to do at the Olympics. It is important to have World Team Trophy before the Olympic Games. (on which team was the best cheering) I like the USA, because they have a lot of fun stuff and it was every time so funny. Actually, when you saw the Kiss & Cry, all the teams were so creative and it was interesting to see what they would do after the program. There is no winner here, everybody was great.
