Please note: The Organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel the Challenge Cup 2021 if due to the Coronavirus (Covid-19) the decision or recommendation of the national/local Government will not agree to conduct such an event or if the travel restrictions into or out of The Netherlands will block the Teams for an unexpected period of time.

1. GENERAL INFORMATION:

Egna Spring Trophy 2021 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2018, the ISU Special Regulations Single and Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2018 and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the Challenge Cup is for skaters who belong to an invited ISU Member, as per Rule 109, paragraph 1, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 2 and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 2 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2030, all skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must present an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation.

All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation

COVID-19 MEASURES

This is subject to Government restrictions at the time of publication.

General rules

- It is MANDATORY during the duration of your stay in Italy to stay between the official hotel and ice rink.
- DO NOT GO to the supermarket in the local area. All shops are closed.
- Keep 1,5-meter distance from each other, except athletes when they are on the ice. Don't come to the competition if you have health issues, even as small as a sore throat or nose cold.
- Please cough and sneeze in your elbow, not your hands.
- If you have been in contact with someone carrying the COVID-19 virus you are not welcome to come to the ice rink, and you must go into self quarantine for a period of 10 days.
- If you have had the COVID-19 virus yourself you must be at least 24 hours free of complaints before you can come to The Netherlands.
- Encouraging athletes through shouting is not allowed. No high fives will be given.
- Wearing a mouth mask is MANDATORY for all persons in the ice rink, shuttle bus and hotel. Solely the use of a face shield is not sufficient.

We have strict protocols and safety and hygiene measures for teams, media, officials and organization. The final COVID-19 protocols will be sent separate from this announcement.

Access to the competition

Due to the current situation, accreditation and access to the competition will only be possible for athletes, coaches and one team leader for each Nation confirmed but he respective Federation. No chaperone allowed.

2.1 PLACE OF THE COMPETITION

Icerink: WürthArena: Via Brennero 7, Egna (BZ) ITALY, heated and indoor ice rink 30m x 60m, bar and restaurant inside the arena.

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2018, Rule 620, paragraphs 1 and 2 for 2017/18.

Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Figure Skating & Pairs Skating 2018, Rule 621 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value. Duration: 4 min., +/- 10 sec.





JUNIOR LADIES AND MEN

Technical Requirements are in accordance with ISU Technical Rules - Single and Pair Skating 2018 and res-pective ISU Communications.

Short Program: 2 min 40 sec, +/- 10 sec Free Skating: 3 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

Junior Pair Skating

Short Program

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2018, Rule 620.

Duration: 2 min., 40 sec., +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Figure Skating & Pairs Skating 2018, Rule 621 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value.

Duration: 3 min 30 sec., +/- 10 sec.

ADVANCED NOVICE GIRLS AND BOYS

Age and requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2018, ISU Communication 2328 and all respective ISU Communications.

Short Program: Max 2 min 20 sec, +/- 10sec

Free Skating: 3 min +/-10 sec

Advanced Novice Pairs

Short Program

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2018 and the respective ISU Communication.

Duration: 2 min., 20 sec., +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Figure Skating & Pairs Skating 2018, Rule 621 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value. Duration: 3 min., +/- 10 sec.





3. ENTRIES

At the accreditation athletes must present a negative molecular Covid-19 test result. The test must not be older than 48 hours.

During the event athletes will have to do an antigenic rapid Covid-19 test every day before the competition (one test before short program and one test before free skating).

3.1 ATHLETES

Competitors must be entered through their respective Member Federation and by sending an email to egna.spring.trophy@gmail.com and figura@fisg.it. The official entry form has to be used and skaters must send to the OC a copy of their passport and PPC document at the time of entries, as well as ISU Clearence Certificate if applicable.. The lack of one of these documents makes it an invalid registration. Each Guest Federation can enter maximum 1 competitor per category plus 1 subsitute, no limits for Italian Federation. Depending on the number of participants the organization will decide whether or not to accept extra entries. Please note that the organizer may divide categories with too many entries into subgroups.

Each category can have a maximum of 24 competitors.

Pairs competition will be confirmed only with a minimum of 12 pairs (in total) entered.

Entries must reach the Event Organizer not later than April 8th, 2021.

Entry Forms, Program Content Sheet and additional forms can be downloaded from ISU website.

3.2 JUDGES

Each participating ISU member may nominate one (1) International or ISU Judge, not later than March 29th, 2020. The Panels will be drawn immediately after the closing of entries. The members concerned will be notified of the result of the draw. Each panel of Judges in Seniors, Juniors, Advanced Novices categories will consist of 5 Judges. The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for rooms and meals for all Referees, the Technical Controllers, the Technical Specialist, the Data and Replay Operators. The Organizing Committee will cover the costs for travel expenses only for Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialist, Data and Replay Operators.

4. CANCELLATION

Cancellation of the competitor entry, has to be done untill **April 13th, 2021**. For any later cancellation the team leader of respective Federation will be asked to pay the entry fee.





5. ENTRY FEE

The Entry Fee must be paid not later than **April 8th**, **2021**. All later payments will be considered late entry fee.

Music has to be sent in file .mp3 to egna.spring.trophy@gmail.com. All files must show the competitor's name, the nation and the exact running time of the music. Each program (short program, free skating) must be saved in a separate file.

9. LIABILITY

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection by Competitors and Officials. Furthermore the OC is not responsible for any contagion that occurs at the event outside of compliance with the prevention pro-tocols implemented.

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the 2021 Spring Trophy to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must be assure full medical attendance and also the return to home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

10. ACCREDITATION

Accreditation will take place at the Würtharena ice rink. The accreditation desk will be open starting Thursday, April 29, 2021.

Athletes are allowed to accreditate only after the antigenic rapid Covid-19 test with negative result. Accreditation will be given to Officials and ISU Office Holders. Accreditation as a team member will be given to all drawn judges, competitors, one coach per competitor.

11. DRAW

Due to the current covid situation, OC wants to avoid gatherings during the draw. For this reason the starting order will online draw made by the Italian Federation FISG on **Monday 19th April**. No draw after short program. Starting order, for free skating will be according the reverse of the short pro-gram results.
