ANNOUNCEMENT / INVITATION

Organized by: Odessa Specialized figure skating school for children and youth of the Olympic reserve "Kryzhynka", Ukrainian Figure Skating Federation Please note: The Organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel the "Victor Petrenko Cup" if due to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) the decision or recommendation of the national/local Government will not agree to conduct such an event or if the travel restrictions into and out of Ukraine will block the Teams for an unexpected period of time.

GENERAL INFORMATION

The Competition "**Victor Petrenko Cup**" will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2021, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules 2021-2022 and ISU Communications and the relevant ISU Communications. The Competition results must be calculated according to the valid ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules.

Participation in the "Victor Petrenko Cup" is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 c) for Novice and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of this Communication.

Citizen/Residence requirements and Clearance Procedure:

In accordance with rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2030 all skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented anther Member, must procedure and ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

<u>COMPETITION VENUE</u>

AII practices and competitions will take place at the Odessa's Palace of Sport. The address is: Shevchenko avenue 31, Odessa - 65058, Ukraine. This complex features an indoor Ice Rink, temperature controlled, with one ice surface 60m. x 30m.

<u>Free Skating</u>: In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021, Rule 612, and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value. Duration: 4 min., +/-10 sec

SENIOR PAIRS

Short Program: The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021 Rule 620, paragraphs 1 and 2 for 2020/21. Duration:2 min., 40sec. +/-10 sec.

<u>Free Skating</u>: In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021, Rule 621, and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value. Duration: 4 min., +/-10 sec

SENIOR ICE DANCE

<u>Rhythm Dance</u>: In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2021, Rule 709. Rhythms, required elements, and guidelines are listed in ISU Communication 2371 and subsequent updates. Duration: 2 min., 50 sec., +/- 10 sec

<u>Free Dance</u>: In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2021, Rule 710. The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Communication 2371 and subsequent updates. Duration: 4 min., +/- 10 sec.

<u>Short Program</u>: The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021, Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2020/21. Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/-10 sec.

<u>Free Skating</u>: In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value. Duration: 3 min., 30 sec., +/-10 sec

JUNIOR PAIRS

Short Program: The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021 Rule 620, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2020/21. Duration:2 min., 40sec. +/-10 sec.

Free Skating: In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021, Rule 621 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value. Duration: 3 min., 30 sec., +/-10 sec

JUNIOR ICE DANCE

Rhythm Dance: In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2021, Rule 709 Rhythms, required elements and guidelines are listed in ISU Communication 2371 and subsequent updates. Duration: 2 min.50 sec. +/- 10 sec

<u>Free Dance</u>: In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Ice Dance 2021, Rule 710. The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Communication 2371 and subsequent updates. Duration: 3 min.30 sec. +/- 10 sec.

Short Program: 2 min 20 sec, +/-10 sec. Free Skating: 3 min +/-10 sec The category will be held in accordance with ISU Communication 2396 (or any update) and all respective ISU Regulations

ADVANCE NOVICE

The Competition comprises the Two (2) Pattern Dances, as well as the Free Dance, which have to be skated according to the current ISU Rules and Regulations including the ISU Communications which are valid for the Season 2021-2022.

Pattern Dances:

Two (2) Pattern Dances are to be skated:

Westminster Waltz and Blues

Couples shall provide their own music for all Pattern Dances.

Free Dance Duration: 3 min. +/- 10 sec.

INTERMEDIATE NOVICE

The Competition comprises the Two (2) Pattern Dances, as well as the Free Dance, which have to be skated according to the current ISU Rules and Regulations including the ISU Communications which are valid for the Season 2021-2022.

Pattern Dances:

One of the two groups, announced for the season, shall be drawn before the first practices of the competition. Each group contains two (2) Pattern Dances:

<u>Group 3: Foxtrot and European Waltz</u> <u>Group 4: Kilian and Starlight Waltz</u> Couples shall provide their own music for all Pattern Dances.

Free Dance Duration: 2 min. 30 sec. +/- 10 sec.

BASIC NOVICE

The Competition comprises the Two (2) Pattern Dances, as well as the Free Dance, which have to be skated according to the current ISU Rules and Regulations including the ISU Communications which are valid for the Season 2021-2022. **Pattern Dances**:

Two (2) Pattern Dances, which will be drawn before the first practices of the competition, are to be skated from the following:

Foxtrot, Dutch Waltz and Rhythm Blues.

Couples shall provide their own music for all Pattern Dances.

Free Dance Duration: 2 min. +/- 10 sec.

ENTRIES

ENTRIES BY NAME: AII Members / Clubs, which are Members of National Figure Skating Federations/Associations associated with the ISU, may enter competitors in each category.

The Entry Forms with the "Program Content Sheet" has to also be returned to the Organizing Committee in due time (not later than September 19, 2021). It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet must be filled in precisely by each couple in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communications. It is not permitted to hand over the Program Content Sheets directly to the acting Officials.

ENTRIES OF JUDGES: Each participating ISU Member may nominate one Judge and one substitute Judge for the event in which the Member has Competitor(s) entered. Only ISU Championships and International Judges will be accepted. The OC reserves the right to limit the number of Judges in accordance with the number of the couple's entries. The confirmation of the list of Judges will be announced in due time.

DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES: Entries must be forwarded to Organizing Committee using the official Entry Forms latest by the September 19, 2021. Entry Forms listing Couples and substitutes must be sent to: <u>victorpetrenkocup@gmail.com</u>

AII entries sent after September 30, 2021 are declared to be late entry. Entry Fees are requested to be paid by bank transfer as it will fasten the accreditation process. Please note that all banking charges have to be borne by the sender.

Entries of Officials: Each participating ISU Member is allowed to nominate a Judge with at least the qualification "International or ISU Judge" in the latest ISU relevant Communication.

The acceptance of the entries of the Judges will be communicated to all participating ISU Members after September 19, 2021.

ACCOMMODATION

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for rooms and meals for accepted Judges and invited Officials beginning with dinner on Monday, October 18, 2021 until breakfast on Monday, October 25, 2021. The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for travel (based on economy fare), rooms and meals for the invited Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialist, and Data Operators. Should any invited Person arrive at the Hotel before or stay longer than the period described above, their room costs and expenses will be the responsibility of the individual and must be paid on arrival.

REGISTRATION

Accreditation will be at the Ice Rink starting on Tuesday, 19, 2021, from 10:00. Please note, that payment by bank transfer is welcome, it will fasten the accreditation process. AII transfer charges are to be paid by the participant. AII the Couples are requested to present a valid passport or personal identity card at the time of registration. In accordance with the ISU Directive please note that at the time of registration (Entry Fee, music, hotel arrangements) we have to copy and file the passport or identity card of the Skaters.

<u>DRAW</u>

Draws will be held at the Official Hotel on Tuesday, October 19, 2021 at 17:00. It will be done by Referees as per Rules 430 and 510. A draw schedule will be published with the official Time schedule. No draw after Short Program, Rhythm Dance / Pattern Dance. Starting order, for Free Prodram/Free Dance will be according the inverse of the Sshort Program, Rhytm Dance / Pattern Dance results.

<u>MUSIC</u>

Each Competitor must have an own USB Stick for each program in the format of a WAV or MP3 file. The music must be handed over to the OC during accreditation.

REWARD

Awarding Ceremonies will be just for the first three places in each category. The Gifts for all participants will be provide at the accreditation point. The exact time of the Awarding Ceremonies will be announced in the detailed schedule in due time.

The Organizers cover the expenses of competition, organization awards and presents. Other costs are not included.

SCHEDULE

Please, be informed that only the daily starting times are fixed. Following the morning start the Time Schedule of the Event is flexible, which means that in case of cancellations certain categories may start some time earlier than in the Preliminary Schedule. Please, be informed that all changes in entries and Preliminary Program might be followed on the information boards at the Ice Rink and at the Official Hotel.
