INTERNATIONAL FIGURE SKATING COMPETITION Single Figure Skating: Junior, Senior

1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The 20th CRYSTAL SKATE OF ROMANIA will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2021, the ISU Special Regulations and Technical Rules for Figure Skating as well as pertinent ISU Communications. Participation in the 20th CRYSTAL SKATE OF ROMANIA is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member, Rule 109, paragraph 1, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3a) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of it.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2030 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

3. ENTRIES Entries of Competitors	 All ISU members and clubs, which are members of National Figure Skating Federations associated with ISU, are invited to take part at the competition. Competitors from categories Senior and Junior must be entered through their Member Federation. Entry forms with the name of skaters must be sent to the following e-mail: frpatinaj2018@gmail.com no later than October 10, 2021 The "Program Content Sheet" for all categories must be returned to the Organizing Committee not later than October 15th 2021. It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet to be filled precisely by each Skater in English using terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication. Entry forms can be downloaded from ISU website and www.frponline.ro 	

Entries of Judges and Technical Panel

- Each ISU Member participating on the competition may enter one or more International or ISU Judge, TC, TS and D/R Operator for different disciplines.
- Nomination for Judge and substitute Judge must be sent along with the entry forms for competitors. The official entry form for Judges must reach the Organizing Committee, not later than October 10, 2021. The OC reserves the right to limit the number of judges in accordance with the number of the Skaters' Entries
- The Panels will be drawn immediately after the closing of entries. The members concerned will be notified of the result of the draw.
- The Organizing Committee will only cover the board and lodging for judges accepted in the panel only for the period: from the dinner before the day of their activity until the end of their activity.
- Confirmation for Judges will be sent to each Member via E-mail <u>frpatinaj2018@gmail.com</u>
- EUR 75 per skater Junior and Senior.
- Payment shall be made on spot in the office of the Organizing Committee inside the Allianz Tiriac Arena during the accreditation.

4. MEALS, LODGING and TRAVEL EXPENSES

Entry fee for Competitors

Expenses

- The organizer will cover the accommodation expenses with full board only for the confirmed Referees, Judges, nominated Technical Controllers and Technical Specialists, Data and Replay Operators in the Hotel Otopeni***.
- Travel expenses will be covered only for Referees, Technical Controllers, Technical Specialist, Data and Replay Operators.
- The organizer will not cover any expenses for competitors, team leaders, coaches or chaperons.

5. MUSIC

The Members are responsible for submitting their Competitor's music as direct attachment to an email to the Organizing Committee until October 15, 2021.

<u>Please note</u>: some music files might exceed the size of a regular email. In this case, an email-based transfer service which allows to send large files could be used to send the file to the OC

- each submission shall be labeled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment and the name(s) of the competitor(s): *Example: ROU_category_Men_SP_IONESCU-Daniel/ ROU_category_Men_FS_IONESCU-Daniel*
- the music files must be sent as WAV or MP3 file formats. Any other format is not acceptable.
- Each Competitor must have a back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a WAV or MP3 file.

<u>Please note:</u> Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient.

6. LIABILITY

In accordance with ISU Regulations, Rule 119, all participants act on their own responsibility. Organizer will
provide medical emergency aid during competition.

7. ACCOMODATION

- All participants except members of Technical Panel and Panel of Judges must cover their accommodation expenses by themselves.
- The Hotel's form must be reached by the Organizing Committee not later than October 10, 2021.
- Accommodation in the hotel must be booked and paid by each member on spot at the ice rink to OC .

- Distance from the ice-rink: 1,3 km.

- The accreditation will start on October 28, 2021 at the Allianz Tiriac Arena.

10. DRAW

- The opening draw for the order of skating for Junior and Senior will be held in the ice rink Allianz Tiriac Arena -Drumul Garii Odai, Bucharest - Otopeni on Thursday, October 28th, 2021 and will be available on the competition website (www.frponline.ro)
- Starting order for the free skating of categories Junior and Senior will be in reverse order of the results of the short program in accordance with RULE 513, paragraph 2, i.

11. AWARDS

The Organizer provides diplomas for all competitors after each event. The three best Skaters in each category will be awarded with medals.

SENIOR WOMEN & MEN	Short Program : The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021, Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 2. Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/- 10 sec.
	Free Skating : In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value. Duration: 4 min. +/- 10 sec.
JUNIOR WOMEN & MEN	Short Program: The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021 Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2021/22 (and listed in ISU Communication 2382). Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/- 10 sec.
	Free Skating : In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value. Duration: 3 min., 30 sec. +/- 10 sec.
