1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The Spring Talents Cup Ukraine 2022 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2021, the ISU Special Regulations for figure skating 2021, and the relevant ISU Communications. ISU Members, as per Rule 109, paragraph 1, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 2 and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 2 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2030, all skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must present an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all skaters and the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation. All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation

COVID-19 MEASURES

This is subject to Government restrictions at the time of publication.

- 1. Keep a 1,5-meter distance from each other, except athletes when they are on the ice
- 2. Wearing a mouth mask is MANDATORY for all persons in the stadium.
- 3. All Team members need to show at the accreditation desk a document confirming receipt of one or more doses of COVID-19 vaccine that are approved by WHO for use in emergencies; or digital COVID certificate confirming vaccination against COVID-19 with vaccines that are approved by WHO for use in emergency situations; negative PCR-test result or antigen test result from medical laboratory, done no more than 72 hours before entry the accreditation desk or proof of recovery from COVID-19.
- 4. Arrival from some countries might be subject to restriction on freedom of movement (self-isolation).
- 5. Up to date list of countries and applicable arrival restriction can be found on a website <u>visitukraine.today</u>
- 6. All Team members will receive a special invitation from the Ukrainian figure skating Federation. You will need to be able to show this upon arrival in Ukraine.

Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/-10 sec.

<u>Free Skating:</u> The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021 and respective ISU Communications.

Duration: 3 min., 30 sec., +/-10 sec

ADVANCED NOVICE GIRLS and BOYS

Age and technical requirements are according to the ISU Technical Rules, Single and Pair Skating 2021, <u>ISU Communication 2396</u> and all respective ISU Communications. <u>Short Program</u>: 2 min 20 sec, +/-10 sec.

3. ENTRIES

ISU Members must enter their competitors using the entry forms. All competitors must be entered through their respective Member Federation/Association.

The **OC** reserves the right to limit the number of participants in each category in case of overcrowding.

Entries by names, as well as <u>Program Content Sheet</u>, must be sent not later than 16th March 2022. It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet must be filled in precisely by each Skater/team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication. It is not permitted to hand over the Program Content Sheets directly to the acting Officials.

Entries of Judges: each participating Federation could nominate one judge with the qualification "Judge for International competitions" or "ISU Judge". The judges have to be on the current ISU list of judges. The organizer decides on the composition of the panel of judges. In case of too many nominated judges, the organizer will draw the judges' panel after the entries' closing date. The written confirmation will be sent to each federation immediately. All judges must be entered through their respective Member Federation/Association. Entries must be sent not later than 16th March 2022. Initial Judges meeting is planned on 30th March 2022. Round Table Discussions are planned 30 minutes after each category.

<u>Entries of Team Officials</u>: Official entries of Team Leaders, Team Officials, Coaches/Choreographers, Team Medical staff, etc., must be made together with Competitors and Judges' entries using the official entry forms.

4. ENTRY FEE

5. CANCELLATION

Cancellation of the competitor entry must be done **till March 25, 2022**. For any latter cancellation, the team leader of respective Federation or Club will be asked to pay the entry fee.

6. MEALS, LODGING and TRAVEL EXPENSES

The organizer will arrange full board accommodation for the Officials. The organizer won't cover any expenses for competitors, team leaders, coaches, etc.



7. MUSIC

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee must be followed:

- The ISU Member is responsible for submitting their Competitor's music as direct attachment to an email to the Organizing Committee (springtalentscup@gmail.com) until 16th March, <a href="mailto:2022. Please note: some music files might exceed the size of a regular email. In this case, an email-based transfer service which allows to send large files could be used to send the file to the OC.
- Each submission shall be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment and the name(s) of the competitor(s): Example:
 - GBR_Junior Men_SP_EXAMPLE-John GBR_Junior Men_FS_EXAMPLE-John
- The music files must be sent as WAV or MP3 file formats. Any other format is not acceptable. Please note: Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient. Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a WAV or MP3 file.
- The exact running time of the music (not skating time) must be communicated to the Organizing Committee when submitting the music and shall be certified by the Competitor/Coach/Team Leader at the time of registration.
- Please note: CDs will not be accepted by the Organizing Committee

8. ACCREDITATION

The official accreditation is planned at the Ice rink and will **start on Tuesday, March 29, 2022 after 18.00.** The accreditation desk opening hours during the competitions will be announced later.

In accordance with the ISU Directive please note that at the time of registration (Entry fee, music, hotel arrangements) we have to copy and file the passport of the Skaters (in case you happen to send it by e-mail beforehand it will make us very happy).

In case of updated COVID-19 measures there might be additional restrictions for chaperones presence during the competitions as a spectators.

9. ACCOMMODATION

All participants must book and pay the accommodation by themselves. The Organizer will make room arrangements for INVITED officials only.

10. TRANSPORTATION

12. PRACTICES

Official practices for Competitors at the "Terminal" Ice Rink begins on Thursday, 31th March 2022. The detailed schedule will be issued later.

For **Seniors** and **Juniors** Official practices are free of charge.

For **Advanced Novice** Official practices are available at a charge:

10 €/skater/20 min session

During practices we play the respective music once for each skater in **Senior** categories. Non-official practices for all Single Skaters are available upon the request for additional fee (20 €/skater/30 min). Please indicate your request at the "Practice request form". This form has to be sent to the OC latest until 20th March 2022 to springtalentscup@gmail.com



13. DRAW

The opening draw for the order of skating will be held **on Wednesday, March 30, 2022**. The exact place and time will be published in the official detailed schedule. Due to Covid-19 pandemic it is possible draw to be done only by Referee and Technical controller without any competitors.

Free Skating draw will be done in reverse to result order after publication of Short Program results. The starting orders and the final time schedule shall be published on the competition website www.talentscup.org at the same date.

14. RESULTS

Results for all categories will be calculated using the last version of ISU Judging System and publised at the official website of the competitions.

15. INSURANCE / LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the Spring Talents Cup 2022 to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials, and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance, including COVID-19, and return to the home country by air transport or other expeditious means of the ill or injured person. The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability concerning a bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials. The medical emergency service will be present at the ice-rink during the Competition.

16. VICTORY CEREMONY

The three best-placed skaters in each event will be announced and honored at the official Victory Ceremony. Due to the COVID-19 and the social distancing, all the information regarding the ceremonies will be detailed in the competition schedule.
