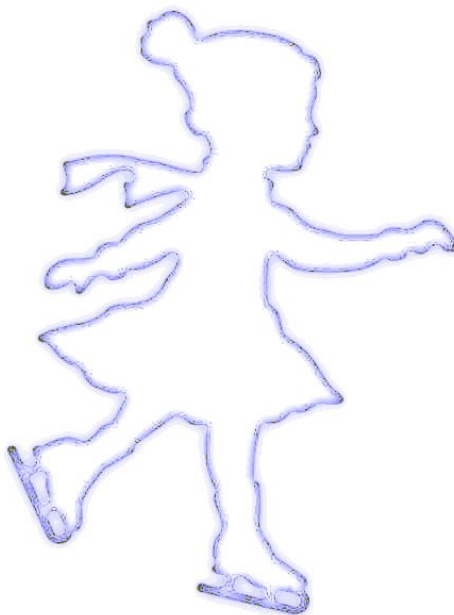

CANCELATION OF COMPETITION

The organizer has the right to cancel competition any time due to legal restrictions or public health issues. Furthermore, in case that competition cannot take place due to legal restrictions or public health issues, the Organizers bear no responsibility for any damage resulting from the cancellation and thus no claims can be made towards the Organizers. The competitors acknowledge that upon cancellation of the competition they do not have the right to claim back the already paid entry fee as the Organizers had various costs concerning the competition.

Cancellation also possible due to insufficient number of registered ISU members / competitors.

GENERAL

Sarajevo Open 2022 Interclub Figure Skating Competition will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2021, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Figure Skating 2021 and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU member, Rule 109, and qualify with regards to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages is in accordance with limits as specified in Rule 108, and they meet citizenship and residency requirements in accordance with Rule 109 and relevant ISU Communications.

ENTRIES

All ISU members and clubs who are members of National Skating Federations associated with ISU are invited to take part at the competition

Entries will be accepted from member federations or clubs as above.

In case of too many entries the organizer reserves the right to limit the number of participants per Member/club.

CHARGES

50 EUR is to be paid for each Competitor single categories

Late entry fee:

65 EUR is to be paid for each competitor

Entry fees are requested to be paid by bank transfer or cash during accreditation.

Please note that credit cards cannot be acceptable as OC has no usage of cards at time of accreditation, so only bank transfer or cash payment at site is acceptable.

*Cancellation of the competitor entry, if any, must reach the organizer by **March 28th at the latest!***

For any late cancellation, after March 28th 2022, entry fee will not be returned.

TECHNICAL DATA

All categories will be conducted according ISU Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair skating and Ice Dancing 2021 and the respective ISU Communications.

CATEGORIES

Single Skating

Intermediate Novice, Base Novice, Cubs and Chicks

INTERMEDIATE NOVICE Boys and Girls: born from 1. 7. 2006 and younger.

Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021, ISU Communication 2328 and all respective ISU Communications.

***Free Skating:** Duration: 3 min, +/- 10 sec*

BASIC NOVICE Boys and Girls: born from 1. 7. 2008 and younger.

Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2021, ISU Communication 2328 and all respective ISU Communications.

***Free Skating:** Duration: 2 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec*

CUBS Boys and Girls: born from 1. 7. 2011 – 30. 6. 2013.

Free Skating: Duration: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

A well balanced CUBS Free Skating Program must contain:

a) Maximum of 4 jump elements for Girls and Boys, one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2) jumps. Triple jumps are not permitted. Any single or double jump (including Double Axel) cannot be executed more than twice in total.

b) There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total) and one spin with no change of position and with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total). Flying entry is allowed.

c) There must be a maximum:

- for Girls one (1) Choreographic sequence which includes at least one 3 seconds long spiral position executed on outside or inside edge. The sequence will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.

- for Boys maximum of one (1) step sequence with a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.

Level explanation: For Cubs in all elements which, are subject to Levels, only features up to **Level 2** will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

The Program Components are only judged in:

- Skating Skills

- Performance

The factor of the Program Components is 2.5

Falls deduction 0, 5 each

CHICKS Boys and Girls: born from 1. 7. 2013 – and younger

Free Skating: Duration: 2 min, +/- 10 sec

A well balanced CHICKS Free Skating Program must contain:

a) Maximum of 4 jump elements for Girls and Boys, one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to two (2) jump combinations or sequences. Jump combination can contain only two (2)

jumps. Triple jumps are not permitted. Any single or double jump (including Double Axel) cannot be executed more than twice in total.

***b)** There must be a maximum of two (2) spins of a different nature (abbreviation), one of which must be a spin combination with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total) and one spin with no change of position and with or without change of foot (minimum of six (6) revolutions in total). Flying entry is allowed.*

***c)** There must be a maximum:*

- for Girls one (1) Choreographic sequence which includes at least one 3 seconds long spiral position executed on outside or inside edge. The sequence will have a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.*
- for Boys maximum of one (1) step sequence with a fixed Base value and evaluated in GOE only.*

***Level explanation:** For Chicks in all elements which, are subject to Levels, only features up to **Level 2** will be counted. Any additional features will not count for Level requirements and will be ignored by the Technical Panel.*

The Program Components are only judged in:

- Skating Skills*
- Performance*

The factor of the Program Components is 2.5.

Falls deduction 0, 5 each

JUDGES

Each participating National Federation or club may nominate 1 International or ISU Judge

Each panel of Judges will consist of minimum 3 Judges.

In case of too many nominated judges the organizer will draw the panels of judges after the entries closing date and written confirmation will immediately be sent to each Federation/Club.

Nomination of Judges and substitutes must be sent with the Entry Forms for Competitors by March 19th, 2022

MEALS, LODGING AND TRAVEL EXPENSES

The Organizer will provide and cover expenses for room and meals for all confirmed / drawn judges, as well as for Invited Officials, from dinner on Thursday, April 7th through breakfast on Monday, April 11th 2022.

All extra expenses will be the responsibility of the individual and their respective member and team leader and must be paid prior to departure.

Travel expenses to and from Sarajevo, transfer costs to and from the Official Hotel and Airport will be covered by the organizer only for invited ISU officials/judges.

MUSIC

All competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on CD format in accordance with Rule 343

Must be clearly labeled with the competitor's name, club/National federation and category in which the competitor is competing. As well as exact running time of the music including any starting signal. Such labeled CD-s and 1 backup drive should be delivered to the organizer immediately after the arrival together with payment of entry fees.

Each program (short program, free skating, short dance, free dance) must be recorded on separate disc.

In addition, skaters/couples must provide a back –up drive for each program.

If music information or payment of entry fees is not provided, accreditation will not be given.

With the entry form the Program Content Sheet must return to the OC in time!

Is not permitted to hand over the Program Content Sheets directly to the acting Officials.

REGISTRATION

All event officials, judges, team leaders, competitors and coaches taking part in the competition are requested to register at the official desk – registration room in Olympic Hall Zetra or Official Hotel. All skaters will be required to present their valid passport prior to receiving accreditation. Accreditation will not be issued without presentation of a valid passport or ISU certificate

LIABILITY

In accordance with ISU Regulations, Rule 119, all participants act on their own responsibility. Organizer accepts no liability for bodily or personal injury or for property loss or damage incurred by any competitor or any kind of Officials.

Organizer will provide medical emergency aid during competition

CALCULATION OF RESULTS

The marking system (new ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2021 will be used.

PRESENTATION OF MEDALS

The first three best placed competitors in each event will be awarded by medals and diplomas, others by diplomas.

The Award Ceremonies will take place following the finish of the given category competitions.
