

Please note: The Organizing Committee reserves the right to cancel the Egna Spring Trophy 2022 if due to the Coronavirus (Covid-19) the decision or recommendation of the national/local Government will not agree to conduct such an event or if the travel restrictions into or out of Italy will block the Teams for an unexpected period of time.

# 1. GENERAL INFORMATION:

Egna Spring Trophy 2022 will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2021, the ISU Special Regulations Single and Pair Skating 2021 and the relevant ISU Communications. (Novice Categories will be held in accordance with ISU Communication 2396 and subsequent updates).

Participation in the Egna Spring Trophy is open for skaters who belong to an invited ISU Member, as per Rule 109, paragraph 1, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 2 and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 2 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2030, all skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must present an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation.

All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation.

### **COVID-19 MEASURES**

This is subject to Government restrictions at the time of publication. Please note that the final COVID-19 protocols will be sent separate from this announcement according to the changing of rules expected by March 31st.

### **General rules**

- Keep 1,5-meter distance from each other, except athletes when they are on the ice. Don't come to the competition if you have health issues, even as small as a sore throat or nose cold.
- Please cough and sneeze in your elbow, not your hands.
- If you have been in contact with someone carrying the COVID-19 virus you are not welcome to come to the ice rink, and you must go into self-quarantine for a period of 10 days.
- If you have had the COVID-19 virus yourself you must be at least 24 hours free of complaints before you can come to Italy.
- Wearing correctly a FFP2 mask is MANDATORY for all persons in the ice rink, shuttle bus and hotel.

We have strict protocols and safety and hygiene measures for teams, media, officials and organization.

### Access to the competition

Due to the current situation, accreditation and access to the competition will only be possible for athletes, coaches and one team leader for each Nation.

# 2. TECHNICAL DATA

#### 2.1 PLACE OF THE COMPETITION

**Icerink:** WürthArena, Via Brennero 7, Egna (BZ) ITALY, heated and indoor ice rink 30m x 60m, bar and restaurant inside the arena.

#### 2.2 CATEGORIES

Advanced Novice - Junior - Senior Ladies, Men

#### SENIOR LADIES AND MEN

Technical Requirements are in accordance with ISU Technical Rules – Single and Pair Skating 2021 and respective ISU Communications. Short Program: 2 min 40 sec, +/- 10 sec Free Skating: 4 min 00 sec, +/- 10 sec

#### JUNIOR LADIES AND MEN

Technical Requirements are in accordance with ISU Technical Rules - Single and Pair Skating 2021 and respective ISU Communications. Short Program: 2 min 40 sec, +/- 10 sec Free Skating: 3 min 30 sec, +/- 10 sec

#### **ADVANCED NOVICE GIRLS AND BOYS**

Age and requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single and Pair Skating 2021, ISU Communication 2396 and all respective ISU Communications.

Short Program: Max 2 min 20 sec, +/- 10sec Free Skating: 3 min +/-10 sec

# 3. ENTRIES

At the accreditation athletes and coaches must present a negative molecular (PCR) Covid-19 test result. The test must not be older than 72 hours.

#### 3.1 ATHLETES

Competitors must be entered through their respective Member Federation and by sending an email to **egna.spring.trophy@gmail.com**. The official entry form has to be used and skaters must send to the OC a copy of their passport and PPC document at the time of entries, as well as ISU Clearance Certificate if applicable. The lack of one of these documents makes it an invalid registration.





Each Guest Federation can enter maximum 1 competitor per category plus 1 substitute, no limits for Italian Federation. Depending on the number of participants the organization will decide whether or not to accept extra entries. Please note that the organizer may divide categories with too many entries into subgroups. **Each category can have a maximum of 24 competitors.** 

#### Entries must reach the Event Organizer not later than March 10th, 2022.

Entry Forms, Program Content Sheet and additional forms can be downloaded from ISU website.

#### 3.2 JUDGES

Each participating ISU member may nominate one (1) International or ISU Judge, not later than March 10th, 2021. The Panels will be drawn immediately after the closing of entries. The members concerned will be notified of the result of the draw. Each panel of Judges in Seniors, Juniors, Advanced Novices categories will consist of 5 Judges. The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for rooms and meals for all Referees, the Technical Controllers, the Technical Specialist, the Data and Replay Operators. The Organizing Committee will cover the costs for travel expenses only for Referees, Technical

Controllers, Technical Specialist, Data and Replay Operators.

# 4. CANCELLATION

Cancellation of the competitor entry, has to be done until **March 15th, 2022**. For any later cancellation the team leader of respective Federation will be asked to pay the entry fee.

# 5. ENTRY FEE

The Entry Fee must be paid not later than **March 10th, 2022**. All later payments will be considered <u>late</u> <u>entry fee.</u> In case a judge has been entered by the respective Member Federation the entry fee for Senior, Junior and Advanced Novice amount to <u> $80\in$ </u>. In case no judge has been entered by the respective Member Federation, the entry fees will be as follows:

# 8. MUSIC AND PLANNED PROGRAM

**Music has to be sent in file .mp3 to <u>egna.spring.trophy@gmail.com</u>. All files must show the competitor's name, the nation and the exact running time of the music. Each program (short program, free skating) must be saved in a separate file and should be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment and the names of the competitors.** 

Example:

SUI\_Senior\_Man\_MUSTERMANN-Max

Together with the entry forms, the "Program Content Sheet" must be returned to the Organizing Committee (Via Mail to: **egna.spring.trophy@gmail.com**). It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet has to be completed precisely by each skater in English using the terminology listed in the respective ISU Communication.

# 9. LIABILITY

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection by Competitors and Officials. Furthermore, the OC is not responsible for any contagion that occurs at the event outside of compliance with the prevention protocols implemented.





In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the 2021 Spring Trophy to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must be assured full medical attendance and also the return to home country by air transport or by other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

# **10. ACCREDITATION**

Accreditation will take place at the Würtharena ice rink. The accreditation desk will be open starting Thursday, April 7, 2022.

Athletes are allowed to have accreditation only after the PCR Covid-19 test with negative result. Accreditation will be given to Officials and ISU Office Holders. Accreditation as a team member will be given to all drawn judges, competitors, one coach per competitor.

# 11. DRAW

Due to the current Covid situation, OC wants to avoid gatherings during the draw. For this reason, the starting order will be drawn by the Italian Federation FISG on <u>Thursday, March 17<sup>th</sup> at FISG</u> <u>Headquarters.</u> No draw after short program. Starting order, for free skating will be according the reverse of the short pro-gram results.

# **12. AWARDING CEREMONY**

Just first three places will be awarded with victory ceremony.
