General Information

Short Program: 2 min 20 sec, +/-10 sec.

Free Skating: 3 min +/-10 sec

The category will be held in accordance with ISU Communication 2396 (or any update) and all respective ISU regulations.

Ice Dance

As Per ISU communication and regulations.

ENTRY

All Federations associated with the ISU may enter up to 3 competitors in each category. The OC reserves the right to limit the number of participants to one (1) Entry in each category in case of overcrowding. The OC also reserve the right to accept more than 3 competitors per ISU Member Federation in each category if circumstances allow.

The maximum number of skaters that will be accepted per event is 20. The OC reserves the right to accept more entries per event where time permits.

In accordance with Rule 378, the Entries by names must be made via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS):

Preliminary entries (by number) must be entered in the ORS not later than July 23rd 2022. Please note that for all persons entered by the Members the procedures in regard to the Declaration for Competitors and Officials entering ISU Events (Rule 131) as outlined in ISU Communication 1876, point 16 (or any update of this Communication) need to be strictly observed.

ENTRY FEE

The fee for each skater is £81.

The fee for each pairs team is £114

In the event of withdrawal, no refunds will be given following the closing date on the 8th August 2022. In the case of a "no-show" at the event, entry fee will not be refunded.

Expenses

The organiser covers the expenses of competition organisation, awards, presents, and the on-site board & lodging only for judges on duty. Travel expenses to and from Sheffield will not be covered by the organiser. The expenses for rooms and meals, travel and transfer of the Team Leaders, Competitors, Coaches, Chaperones and other Team officials will not be covered by the organiser.

Travel fees will be paid only to Technical Specialists, Technical Controllers and Referees based on economy air fare.

Accreditation

Accreditation will be held at Ice Sheffield starting from noon on Thursday 25th August 2022. All Competitors are requested to present a valid passport or personal identity card at the time of registration. Accreditation will be given to all Referees, Assistant Referees, ISU Office Holders and Guests. Accreditation as a Team Member will be given to all entered Judges and Competitors, one Team Leader, one coach per Competitor

MUSIC UPLOAD

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee must be followed:

- the ISU Member is responsible for submitting their Competitor's music as direct attachment to an email to the Organizing Committee via this link

Please note: some music files might exceed the size of a regular email. In this case, an email-based transfer service which allows to send large files could be used to send the file to the OC.

- each submission shall be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment, and the name(s) of the competitor(s):

- the music files must be sent as WAV or MP3 file formats. Any other format is not acceptable.

Please note: Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient.

- Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a WAV or MP3 file.
- The exact running time of the music (not skating time) must be communicated to the Organizing Committee when submitting the music.

If the music files have been submitted within the above-mentioned deadline to the Organizing Committee, then the music team of the Organizing Committee is entirely responsible for the correct execution of the

music. In case of issues with submitted music files the Organizing Committee may request at the time of registration a secondary copy of the music files. In case the music files have not been submitted in time to

the Organizing Committee, the skater(s) must present their music latest at the time of registration on the above defined mean and in the defined format.

Please note: CDs will not be accepted by the Organizing Committee.

The titles, composers and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating Program for Single, for the Rhythm and Free Dance Program for Ice Dance must all be entered, in detail, by the ISU Member or the Skater(s) on the dedicated ISU platform.

If music information is not complete and/or the music is not provided, accreditation will not be given.

The Planned Program Content must also be entered by the ISU Member or the Skater(s) on the dedicated ISU platform. It is mandatory that the Program Content information be filled in precisely by each Skater/team

in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

Entry of Judges

Each participating ISU Member may nominate one Judge for the event in which the Member has Competitor(s) entered. Only ISU Championships and International Judges will be accepted. The OC reserves the right to limit the number of judges in accordance with the number of the Skaters Entries. The Organizing Committee will cover the on-site board and lodging only for judges accepted in the panel only for the period: from the dinner before the day of their activity until the end of their activity. Please be aware that judges not involved in the panel have to cover their own expenses (board and lodging). The confirmation of the list of judges will be announced in due time.
