#### **Competition Regulation**

The Competition will be conducted in accordance with the <u>ISU Constitution and General Regulation 2022.</u>

The Anti-Doping tests will be conducted by the International Anti-Doping Agency (ITA) in accordance with the World Anti-doping Agency's Code and International Standard for Testing. Based on and the European Olympic Committees.

To conduct the doping tests of Figure Skating, there will be doping control room at the Ice Arena "Claudio Vuerich".



#### **Conditions of Participation**

Participation in the Competition of EYOF 2023 is open to all Competitors who belong to a NOC and be an ISU Member in accordance with Rule 130, paragraph 2 and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3. b) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and Communication No. 2030 (or any updated of this Communication). In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2030 (or any update of this Communication), all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, <u>must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate</u>.

Please note that for organizational reasons the ISU Clearance Certificate must be presented via NOC <u>before</u> receiving the accreditation for verification (<u>NOT at the accreditation</u>). Without the ISU Clearance Certificate, competitors cannot receive the accreditation.

All competitors must be entered through their respective Member Federation via the NOC before the 21<sup>st</sup> December 2022.

#### Music

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulation & Technical Rules Single & Pair skating and Ice Dance 2022, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee must be followed:

- All Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality in a format and means announced in the announcement of the competition in accordance with Rule 112;
- Each submission shall be labelled with the competitor's name, the Nation, competition event and the exact running time of the music (not skating time) including any starting signal and must be submitted at the time of registration;
- Each program (Short Program/Free Program) must be recorded on a separate track;
- Competitors must provide an own back-up drive (USB stick) for each program in a format and means as per the announcement of the competition in accordance with Rule 112 (WAV or MP3 files)

Please note that CDs will NOT be accepted by the Organizing Committee.

A simple music form for the programs of each competitor indicating the name and the duration of the music must be sent via NOC no later than the 21<sup>st</sup> December 2022). If music information is not complete or/and the music is not provided accreditation will not be given.

#### **Judges Selection Procedure**

Each Panel of Judges will consist of a minimum of 5 Judges and a maximum of 7 Judges. Each participating NOC is requested to nominate one judge with at least the qualification "International judge", one judge can be nominated by NOCs: for Girls' competition (if the NOC has a skater in this discipline), for Boys' competition (if the NOC has a skater in this discipline) or for both competition (if the NOC has a skater in both disciplines).

#### **Composition of Judges Panel**

During the Chef de Mission Seminar 19-22 September 2022, seven judges have been drawn for each Panel.

The seating order will be drawn 45 minutes prior to each segment of the category. The Referees and the Technical Panels (technical specialists and controllers), as well as Data and Replay Operators, have been appointed by the OC and FISG.

Judges were drawn at the Chef de Mission Seminar in Amaro on 21<sup>st</sup> September 2022 in the presence of the Chefs de Mission and the draw was supervised by the EOC Sport Director Peter Brull.

#### **Final entries**

The entries by name, indicating the names of the skaters in the discipline concerned (long List) must be submitted <u>no later than the 21<sup>st</sup> December 2022</u>, and the final Entries by name (Short List), <u>no later than 9<sup>th</sup> January 2023</u> by the NOC in the accreditation system EYOF2023.

#### **Practice**

Official Practice for Competitors begins on Tuesday 25th January 2023. The detailed schedule on the table below Official program.

## **Planned Program Content (PPC)**

It is mandatory that for each competitor the official "Planned Program Content Sheet" must be submitted to the EYOF OC. The form available on Extranet must be dully filled and sent via NOC by 21st December 2022. The Planned Program Content information of each skater sheet must be filled in precisely in English, using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

#### **Results**

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2022, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used.

### **Medal Ceremonies**


Medal ceremonies will take place for the three best placed skaters after the conclusion of each final event (approximately in 15 minutes) on ice.

# **Description**

**Pontebba** is located in the Tarvisio mountain area and until the First World War the border between Italy and Austria was here: on the old maps it is still possible to read the ancient names Venetian Pontebba, Italian Pontebba and Pontafel to indicate the Carinthian part. Very interesting is the Parish Church of Santa Maria Maggiore that preserves the wonderful wooden altar (Flügelaltar) which dates back to 1517.




## <u>The Ice Arena – Claudio Vuerich</u>



The Arena has a capacity of 1200 pax.


