1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The **1st Maria Olszewska Memorial 2023** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2022, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2022, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the **1st Maria Olszewska Memorial 2023** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

All competitors must be entered through their respective Member Federation.

3.1.1 General

New Skaters or new Couples/Pairs who are not in ORS yet should be created as soon as possible, well in advance before the entry deadline in order to avoid missing the entry deadline.

Payment has to be done at the accreditation desk (at ice rink). Only cash will be accepted.

OC has an authority to enter skaters after deadline to ORS.









3.1.3 Entries of Judges

Each participating ISU Members may nominate one international / ISU (1) judge. The second judge can be nominated only if participating member has enetered skaters in all categories. It is recommended that the second Judge, if possible, has the qualification for Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance. The Host Member may nominate a judge in each discipline in which they have entries.

The Entries of Judges must be made via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) and reach the Organizing Committee and the ISU Secretariat, not later than **Friday**, **March 3**, **2023 – 22:00 h** (**local time Łódź**).

Each panel of Judges will consist of a minimum of 5 Judges.

3.1.4 Entries of Team Members

Official entries of Team Leaders, Assistant Team Leaders, Team Officials, Team Medical Staff and Coaches will be accepted. Accreditation will be provided to those who are officially accepted by the Organizer.

The Member Federations guarantee that the requested accreditation of Team Members will correspond to their function within the team and the Federation.

The names of all team members must be submitted via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) and must reach the Organizing Committee and the ISU Secretariat not later than **Friday**, **March 3**, **2023 – 22:00 h (local time Łódź)**.

4. MEALS, LODGING and TRAVEL EXPENSES

The organizer will provide and cover the expenses for travel, rooms and meals <u>only</u> for Referees, Technical Specialists, Technical Controllers, Data/Replay Operators.

Judges will have covered the expences for rooms and meals.

5. PRACTICE

Official practice for Competitors begins on **Wednesday**, **March 15**, **2023**. The detailed schedule will be issued at the time of registration.

Please note!

Practices will be only provided for Senior, Junior categories in Sigles, Pairs and Ice Dance.

OC will provide extra paid practices on **Tuesday, March 14, 2023** begining at 16:00 – 150EUR/1hour

6. MUSIC / PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

The following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee must be followed:

the music files must be sent as WAV or MP3 file formats. Any other format is not acceptable. Please note: Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient. Each Competitor must have an own back-up drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a WAV

or MP3 file. The exact running time of the music (not skating time) must be communicated to the Organizing Committee when submitting the music and shall be certified by the Competitor/Coach/Team Leader at

During the 1st Official Practice, the music will be played as indicated in the Practice Schedule and will allow to verify the correctness of the submitted music. If there is an issue with the music, the Team Leader/Coach may be allowed to change the music by presenting an acceptable reproduction to the Organizing Committee's Music Team (USB Stick with file format of WAV or MP3 file).

If the music files have been submitted within the above-mentioned deadline to the Organizing Committee, then the music team of the Organizing Committee is entirely responsible for the correct execution of the music. In case of issues with submitted music files the Organizing Committee may request at the time of registration a secondary copy of the music files. In case the music files have not been submitted in time to the Organizing Committee, the skater(s) must present their music latest at the time of registration on the above defined mean and in the defined format.

<u>Please note</u>: CDs will <u>not</u> be accepted by the Organizing Committee.

The titles, composers and orchestras of the music to be used for the Short Program and Free Skating Program for Single, for the Rhythm and Free Dance Program for Ice Dance and for the Exhibition must all be entered, in detail, by the ISU Member or the Skater(s) on the dedicated ISU platform.

If music information is not complete and/or the music is not provided, accreditation will not be given.

The Planned Program Content must also be entered by the ISU Member or the Skater(s) on the dedicated ISU platform. It is mandatory that the Program Content information be filled in precisely by each Skater/team in English using the terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication.

7. ARRIVAL OF PARTICIPANTS / TEAMS

All Referees, the Technical Panel (Technical Controller, Technical Specialists, Data & Replay Operators) Judges, Competitors, Team Leaders, Team Officials, Team Medical Staff and Coaches are requested to announce to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible but not later than Wednesday, March 8, 2023, the name of the airlines, flight numbers, dates and times of arrival. The detailed travel information needs to be submitted via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS).

The nearest airport to Łódź is Reymont Airport Łódź and Chopin Airport – Warsaw with a distance of 134 km to Łódź

Accreditation as a Team Member will be given to all entered Judges, Competitors, Team Leaders Assistant Team Leader, Coaches, Team Official of ISU Members Accreditation will only be granted to persons in those various functions if officially entered and named through their ISU Member.

The ISU Member certifies with the entries in ORS the indicated functions within the team of all team members. Any misuse of any function will be sanctioned by the ISU/OC.

Accreditation will be given to appointed Event Officials.

Chaperons will not receive accreditation.

10. RESULTS

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2022, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used.

World Standing points will also be awarded according to the "ISU World Standings Procedure", that can be found on the ISU website (www.isu.org) under Single & Pairs/Ice Dance - World Standings.
