ANNOUNCEMENT WELCOME

The Organizing Committee is glad to invite you and your club to participate in the **WOLMAR Spring Cup 2023** International Figure Skating Competition which is held in Valmiera, Latvia.

1. GENERAL

The **WOLMAR Spring Cup 2023** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2022, the Special Regulations and Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2022, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the **WOLMAR Spring Cup 2023** is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3. a) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 in accordance with the ISU General Regulations 2022 or any update of this and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification. All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation.

The OC can have the final decision about the over-quota for any club/country/ federation or refuse to accept entry (fully or partially)

4. ENTRIES FOR COMPETITION

All the members of ISU and Clubs, being members of National Skating Federations associated with ISU, are invited to take part in this competition.

Members can enter any quantity of Skaters/Couples into each category.

Organizers have the right to refuse or limit participation in the competition. The attached entry forms have to be filled in precisely and can be sent by e-mail to the address given below by **March 10**th, **2023** to:

NB! Changing categories for skaters is not allowed after the deadline for entries! Please note that any replacements in the entry form have to be made into the same class and category. Please note that any replacements in the entry form have to be made before 29.03.2023.

5. ENTRIES

5.1. ENTRY FEE:

Single Skating – 90.00 Eur

5.2. ENTRY FEE PAYMENT:

Entry fees must be paid after confirmation of member participation. Bill must be paid with one (1) transaction for all the country/member participants. The Organizer will not return the entry fee but you can replace one skater for another in the same category only and not later than one week before the draw.

6. OFFICIALS

Each participating ISU Member may nominate one (1) Judge with the qualification "Judge for International competitions" or "ISU Judge" per discipline, double-duty Judges are very welcome. The Panels of Judges will consist of a minimum of five (5) Judges in all panels.

The Referees and the Technical Panel members will be invited by the Organizing Committee. In case of too many nominated Judges, the organizer will draw the panel of judges immediately after the closing date for the entries. The result of such a draw will be communicated to all ISU Members involved in writing immediately after the conclusion of such a draw.

7. EXPENSES

Competitors and all other Team Members are responsible for their own travel, accommodation and meal expenses.

8. LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, each Member participating in the WOLMAR Spring Cup 2023 must provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and the return to the home country by air transport or other expeditious means of the ill or injured person.

Please note – livestream video and photography is provided during all event.

The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection with the event mentioned above.

9. THE CODE OF ETHICS

All the skaters, coaches, judges, and chaperons should follow the ISU Communication 2342, (or any update of this Communication). Action against this rule conducts by itself the disqualification of the skater.

10. MUSIC

In accordance with Rule 343 in the ISU Special Regulations Technical Rules Single Pair Skating and Ice Dance, the following method to submit the Competitor's music to the Organizing Committee must be followed:

• The participating member is responsible for submitting their Competitor's music as direct attachment to an email to the Organizing Committee (wolmarspringcup@gmail.com) until March 24th, 2023.

Please note: some music files might exceed the size of a regular email. In this case, an email-based transfer service which allows sending large files could be used to send the file to the OC.





• Each submission shall be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment and the name(s) of the competitor(s).

Example: LAT_Junior_Men_FS_BERZINS Janis LAT_Senior_Women_SP_OZOLA Liga

- The music files must be sent in WAV or MP3 file formats. Any other format is not acceptable. Please note: Files in MP3 format may have a significant difference in the music quality when reproduced. The Organizing Committee in this case is not responsible if the music quality would be insufficient.
- Each Competitor must have its own backup drive (USB Stick) for each program in the format of a WAV or MP3 file.
- The exact running time of the music (not skating time) must be communicated to the Organizing Committee when submitting the music and shall be certified by the Competitor/Coach/Team Leader at the time of registration.
- During the 1st Official Practice, the music will be played as indicated in the Practice Schedule and will allow verifying the correctness of the submitted music. If there is an issue with the music, the Team Leader/Coach may be allowed to change the music by presenting an acceptable reproduction to the Organizing Committee's Music Team (USB Stick with the file format WAV or MP3 file).

11. PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENTS

With the entry forms, the "Program Content Sheet" must be returned to the Organizing Committee e-mail: wolmarspringcup@gmail.com, it is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet be completed precisely by each skater/couple in English using the proper terminology.

12. AWARDS

The top three competitors in each event (Final results) will be honoured and awarded with Trophies, special presents and diplomas. The exact time of the Awarding Ceremonies will be announced in the detailed schedule in due time.

13. RESULTS

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating 2022, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used.

14. ACCREDITATION / REGISTRATION

15. ACCOMMODATION

16. TRANSPORTATION
