The Jelgava Cup will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General

Regulations 2022, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skatingand Ice Dance

2022, and the relevant ISU Communications.

Participation in the Jelgava Cup is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and

qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fallwithin the limits

specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 a) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency

requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of

this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 all

Skaters whodo not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who,

although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an

ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if

applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation.

Duration: 4 minutes, +/- 10 sec.

WOMEN

Short Program

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022, Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 2.

Duration: 2 minutes and 40 seconds, +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value.

Duration: 4 minutes, +/- 10 sec.

JUNIOR MEN

Short Program

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022 Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2023/24.

Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/- 10 sec

Free Skating

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value.

Duration: 3 min., 30 sec. +/- 10 sec.

JUNIOR WOMEN

Short Program

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022 Rule 611, paragraphs

1 and 3 for 2023/24.

Duration: 2 min., 40 sec. +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating

In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2022, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value.

Duration: 3 min., 30 sec. +/- 10 sec.

ADVANCED NOVICE BOYS **Short Program**

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU

Duration: 2 minutes and 20 seconds, +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating In accordance with ISU Communication No. 2562

Duration: 3 minutes, +/- 10 sec.

ADVANCED NOVICE GIRLS **Short Program**

The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU

Communication No. 2562

Duration: 2 minutes and 20 seconds, +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating In accordance with ISU Communication No. 2562

Duration: 3 minutes, +/- 10 sec.

3. ENTRIES

All Entries to the Jelgava Cup must be submitted using official forms. The forms have to be sent to the OC by e-mail: jelgavacup@inbox.lv

The deadline for entries is August 21st, 2023.

ENTRY FEE

90€ per skater

4. APPOINTED EVENT OFFICIALS

This Jelgava Cup event will follow the principles of International Skating Union for appointing the event officials. The members of each individual Technical Panel, Referee and Judges will have at least the qualification "International" and will be from Different ISU Members.

5. MUSIC AND PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

All competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality on USB flash drive. Each file shall be labelled with the name of the ISU Member, name of the category, segment and the name of the competitor.

6. RESULTS

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating 2022, Rule 352 and Rule 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used.

7. AWARDS

The top three competitors in each event (Final results) will be honored and awarded by Trophies. All the skaters will receive memory presents at the accreditation desk. The exact time of the Awarding Ceremonies will be announced in the detailed schedule in due time. Please note that only top 3 skaters are represented at the award ceremony.

8. INSURANCE AND LIABILITIES

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole obligation of each Member participating in events, to

provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious. It is an internal matter of each ISU Member to decide the issue who shall pay the premium for such insurance.

The OC assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection incurred by Competitors and Officials.

9. ACCOMODATION

There is no Official Hotel at this event. Teams are requested to organise their accommodation by themselves. The OC will organise accommodation to Invited Event Officials only.

10. ARRIVAL OF TEAMS

The nearest airport is Riga Airport (RIX) with a distance of 40 km to the venue.

The OC will not be providing transportation from the airport for competitors, coaches, Team Leaders and Team Staff.

11.TIME SCHEDULE

Detailed time schedule will be published at www.skating.lv soon after the close of entries.

12. DRAW

The Starting orders will be drawn by the representative of Technical Controller/Referee for the short program. Starting orders for the second segment FS will be reverse order of the result of SP.

13. THE CODE OF ETHICS

All the skaters, coaches, judges, chaperons should follow the ISU Communication 2478, (or any update of this Communication). Action against this rule conducts by itself the disqualification of the skater.

14. LIVE STREAM & PHOTOS

Please note: live stream video provided during all the competition long. Professional photographers are working at the ice rink and organizers has a right to use any photo for commercial purposes

15. ACCREDITATION

At Zemgale Ice Arena, OC office during competition days. In accordance with the ISU Directive please note that at the time of registration (Entry fee, music) we have to copy and file the passport of the Skaters.

16. PLANED PROGRAM CONTENT

The "Program Content Sheet" must be returned to the Organizing Committee before September 4th <u>jelgavacup@inbox.lv</u> It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet be completed precisely by each skater in English using the proper terminology.
