OVERVIEW

The **Kings Cup International** for Singles will be held, October 5-8, 2023, at Toyota Sports Performance Center facility in El Segundo, California, in conjunction with the LA Autumn Classic Figure Skating Competition. This will be an ISU Minimum Technical Score event featuring junior and senior singles. Additionally, skaters may earn World Standing points according to ISU Communication **2550**.

GENERAL

The **2023 Kings Cup International** will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2022, the Special Regulations and Technical Rules for Singles & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2022 and in accordance with all pertinent ISU Communications.

Additional remarks

Participation in the competition is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member, Rule 109, paragraph 1, and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108 paragraph 3. b) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication **2526**. Passports of the skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation.

Toyota Performance Center ice surfaces are two 60mX25m (NHL size) and the Pond-smaller practice surface. The facility has Kings Cove Café and concessions, and Ultimate Skate & Hockey Pro shop.

All Singles competitive events will take place on the 'middle rink', which is a 60m x 25m NHL size Rink surface.

ENTRY FEE

The entry fee: SINGLES \$395 USD

Entry fees are required at time of registration and should be paid by credit card online. There will be no entry fee refunds under any circumstances (inclusive of withdrawals). If requested in advance, member federations will be allowed to wire registration funds directly.

ENTRIES

All entries must be submitted online by **Sunday, September 10, 2023** through the US Figure Skating Event Management System.

The Organizer reserves the right to accept a limited number of entries. Skaters will be notified of their acceptance by **Friday, September 15, 2023**. Should skaters not be accepted, skaters will be offered an opportunity to compete in AUTUMN CLASSIC or be refunded (minus processing fees). Skaters must let the Organizing Committee know within 24 hours of notification or skater will automatically be transferred into equivalent AUTUMN CLASSIC event and no refunds will be given at that point.

JUDGES, REFEREES AND TECHNICAL PANEL

The Organizer will provide ground transportation and meals for all invited judges, referees and technical panel officials beginning with dinner on **Wednesday, October 4, 2023** through breakfast on **Monday, October 9, 2023**. The Organizer will additionally cover economy roundtrip airfare for invited Technical Panel officials (Referee, TC, TS, ATS, Data/Video) and invited judges.

ONSITE REGISTRATION

Accreditation will take place at The Toyota Sports Performance Center. The accreditation desk will be open starting Wednesday, October 4, 2023. All persons to be accredited are kindly asked to accredit upon arrival. Accreditation will be given to Officials and ISU Office Holders. Accreditation as a team member will be given to all drawn judges, competitors, one coach per competitor, and one chaperone* per competitor.

DRAWS AND JUDGES' MEETINGS

The **draw for the initial starting orders** will take place in accordance with ISU Rules 512 & 513 paragraph 1. Times and specific location will be announced and posted on the Los Angeles Figure Skating Club site www.LAFSC.org

For Free Skating there will be no draws. The reverse order of places in the Short Program will be used for the free skating starting order.

The **initial judges' meeting** will be held on Thursday, October 5, 2023 at the Toyota Sports Performance Center.

The **Round Table Discussions** will take place on Saturday, October 7, 2023 and Sunday October 8, 2023. Times TBD based on schedule.

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

The competitors, coaches and additional federation officials are responsible for their own arrangements concerning ground transportation to and from the official hotel to the airport. Complimentary airport shuttle is provided from hotel.

RESULTS AND ISU MINIMUM SCORE

The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Special Regulations Single and Pair Skating 2022, Rule 352 and 353 (Determination and publication of results) will be used.

This will be an ISU Minimum Technical Score event.

STEP ONE

Log in to www.USFSAonline.org. Foreign skaters must create non-member accounts to access registration, [click here](#) for instructions.

STEP TWO

Click blue EMS button followed by COMPETITION REGISTRATION.
Select “2023 Kings Cup International”

STEP THREE

Select “Junior International” or “Senior International” and proceed to check out

EMS COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS: After registration is complete, all skaters and declared coaches will have access to the EMS Portal.
