# 1. GENERAL REGULATIONS

The **Kaunas Ice Autumn Cup** will be conducted in accordance with ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2022, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair skating and Ice Dance 2022 as well as all pertinent ISU Communications.

Participation in the **Kaunas Ice Autmn Cup** is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member, Rule 109, paragraph 1 and qualify with regard to eligibility, according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3. a) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2526 or any update of this Communication.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 2526 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must to be presented at the accredetation of the event for verification.

All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation.

# 2. PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

# **SENIOR MEN:**

**Short program** The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules

Single & Pair skating 2022, Rule 611, paragraph 1 and 2.

Duration: 2 minutes and 40 seconds +/- 10 sec.

Free skating In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair skating 2022, Rule

612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be

paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value.

Duration: 4 minutes +/-10 sec.

#### **SENIOR WOMEN:**

**Short program** The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules

Single & Pair skating 2022, Rule 611, paragraph 1 and 2.

Duration: 2 minutes and 40 seconds +/-10 sec.

Free skating In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair skating 2022, Rule

612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be

paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value.

Duration: 4 minutes +/-10 sec.

# **JUNIOR MEN:**

**Short program** The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules

Single & Pair skating 2022, Rule 611, paragraph 1 and 3 for season

2023/2024.

Duration: 2 minutes and 40 seconds +/-10 sec.

Free skating In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair skating 2022, Rule

612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be

paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value.

Duration: 3 minutes and 30 seconds  $\pm$  10 sec.

# **JUNIOR WOMEN:**

**Short program** The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules

Single & Pair skating 2022, Rule 611, paragraph 1 and 3 for season

2023/2024.

Duration: 2 minutes and 40 seconds +/-10 sec.

Free skating In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair skating 2022, Rule

612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be

paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value.

Duration: 3 minutes and 30 seconds  $\pm$  10 sec

# 3. ENTRIES

#### REGISTRATION OF ENTRIES

Competitors taking part in Senior and Junior categories must be entered through their Respective Member Federation. Each Member Federation and club may enter any number of competitors in each category. In case of too many entries, the OC reserves the right to limit the number of participants.

All entries to the Kaunas Autumn Cup must be submitted using official forms. **The forms have to be sent to the OC by e-mail:** competition@kaunasice.lt

#### Deadline of entries

Preliminary entry forms must be sended by 23rd of September, 2023 at the latest.

Entries that are sent/received after the mentioned deadline will not be accepted.

#### ENTRY FEE

# 90 EUR per skater

Each club has to pay 100% of the total amount for its participant's right after the entry form confirmation, but not later then <u>Octeber 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2023</u>. The participant is included in the entry list only after a 100% payment. Entry fees are not refunded.

- We kindly ask the clubs to make one payment for all its participants.
- Please ensure that we receive the net amount the required payment sum.
- All registration related procedures (registration, annulment, changes) must be submitted to the Event Coordinator in written form.
- In case a skater has been entered in the competition, but cannot participate, she/he can be replaced by another skater in the same category.
- Participating teams should inform of any changes in their team as soon as possible, but not later than October 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2023

# 4. MUSIC and Planned Program Content

- The participating member is responsible for submitting their Competitor's music as direct attachement to an e-mail: <a href="mailto:competition@kaunasice.lt">competition@kaunasice.lt</a> until September 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2023.
- Each file shall be labelled with the name of ISU Member, name of the category, segment and the name of the competitor.

Example: EST\_SeniorMen\_SP\_Smith\_John LAT JuniorMen FS Jhonson Max

- The music files must be sent as WAV or MP3 file format. Any other format is not acceptable.
- Each competitor also must have an USB flash drive with excellent quality music for each program in the format of or MP3 file.

#### **Planned Program Content**

The "Planned program content sheet" must be returned to the OC email: <a href="mailto:competition@kaunasice.lt">competition@kaunasice.lt</a> until September 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2023. It is mandatory that the Program Content Sheet must be completede precisely by each skater in English using the proper elements abreviation.

# 5. TIME SCHEDULE / RESULTS

- > Time schedule will be announced at www.kaunasice.lt soon after the close of entries.
- ➤ The marking system (ISU Judging System) as described in ISU Technical Rule Single & Pair Skating 2022, Rule 353 (determination and publication of results) will be used.

# 6. AWARDS

- Three first standings of each category (final results) shall be awarded with a trophie and a medal.
- All competitors shall receive a diploma and memory gifts.
- The exact time of the Awarding Ceremony will be announced in the detailed schedule in due time.

# 7. APPOINTED EVENT OFFICIALS

Kaunas Ice Autumn Cup event will follow the priciples of ISU for appointing the event officials. The members of each inividual Technical Panle, Referee and Judges will have at least the qualification "International" and will be from different ISU Members.

# 8. INSURANCE AND LIABILITIES

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole responsibility of each Member participating in the event, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athlethes, officials and all other members of the Members team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious.

The OC assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or pesonal injury or property damage incurred in connection with the event mentioned above.

#### 9. EXPENSES

Competitors and all other team Members are responsible for their own travel, accommodation and meal expenses.

**For all officials** of the competition the organizer will take care of accomodation and meals for all Referees, Judges and Technical Panel.

10. ACCREDITATION

Accreditaion will take placeat the ice rink at the Kaunas Ice Palace in the OC office during competition

days. Please note that in accordance with ISU Directive at the time of registration the competitor has to

have a passport with themselves, because we'll have to make a passport copy and file.

11. CODE OF ETHICS

All skaters, coaches and judges, chaperons should follow the ISU Communication 2478 (or any update of this Communication). Acctions against this Rule conducts by itself the disqualification of the skater.

13. LIVE STREAM & PHOTOS

During all competition long there will be taken photos by a professional photographer and live stream

will be provided. The Organiser has a right tu use any photo for commercial purposes.

14. ARRIVAL AND ACCOMODATION

The nearest airport is **Kaunas Airport (KAU)** – 20 min. (12 km) from the Venue place.

And the  $2^{nd}$  nearest airport is **Vilnius airport (VNO**) – 1h (100 km) from the Venue place.

The OC can arrange transportation for the participants and accompanying persons from Kaunas or

Vilnius airport if there's a need, for additional price:
