# **General Regulations**

The competitions will be held under the 2022 ISU General Regulations and Special Regulations/Technical Rules for Short Track Speed Skating and ISU Communication No. 2580.

Participation is open to all ISU Members. This competition is part of the ISU World Cup Short Track 2023/24.

#### **Track Conditions**

The Maurice Richard Arena has an artificially refrigerated indoor ice surface of 60 x 30 meters. Protective padding covers the boards in accordance with Rule 280, paragraph 5 and ISU Communication No. 2365 (or any further update). The standard track will be laid out 111.12 meters to the lap.

#### Entries<sup>1</sup>

- a) Entries can only be made using the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) for World Cup Short Track Speed Skating on <a href="https://ors.isu.swisstiming.com/account/login">https://ors.isu.swisstiming.com/account/login</a>
- b) Entries with the number of Competitors, substitutes, coaches & Team leader and requirements of accommodation must be submitted by September 21, 2023.

In addition, please send an ID picture of each Team Member to the Organizing Committee in electronic format, not later than October 10, 2023, enabling the OC to prepare all accreditations in advance.

The number of other personnel travelling with the Team shall be communicated at the same time ISU Members failing to comply in time with these requirements will receive no support from the Organizing Member for:

- Hotel booking;
- Travel arrangements between airport and hotel;
- Travel arrangements between hotel and ice rink;
- Access to Closing Banquet (if held);
- Preferred times for additional training sessions.

All these costs and any additional costs incurred will be for the full account of the ISU Members concerned.

- c) Final Entries must reach the Organizing Committee using the Online Registration System must be submitted at the latest by 20:00 hrs (local time) on October 10, 2023. (see ISU Communication No. 2580, paragraph 5), and the following information must be communicated to the Organizing Committee:
  - Names of the Competitors and a list of alternate names per category with their International Registration
     Numbers
  - Names of the Competitors and their personal best time, recorded during the period of eligibility, for all individual distances they might participate in
  - Names of the Competitors for each of the respective individual distances;
  - Confirmation of participation in all the competitions of the Relay.

Only the Competitors listed on the Final Entry, respecting the maximum number of entries allowed, can attend and receive an accreditation for the Event.

Final Entries that do not comply with these requirements are considered Post Entries. See Rule 115.

d) Competitors must be present in Montreal at the latest at 18:00 hours on Thursday, October 19 or the Organizing Committee must receive documented proof that the competitors are in transit and will arrive in due time for the World Cup Competition. Competitors who do not comply with these requirements will be excluded.

e) Please note that for all persons entered by the Members, the procedures regarding the Declaration for Competitors and Officials (all team Officials requiring an accreditation) entering ISU Events (Rule 131) as outlined in ISU Communication No. 1628 need to be strictly observed. Declaration Forms must be uploaded in the ORS in each Competitors and Team Officials' profile prior submitting the Entries.

# Citizenships/Residence Requirements and Clearance Procedure

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2526, all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the ISU Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another ISU Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

## **World Cup points**

The points scoring at the World Cup Competition is made in accordance with ISU Communication No. 2580, paragraphs 10, 11 and 12.

# **Anti-Doping**

Anti-Doping tests will be carried out according to the ISU Anti-Doping Rules and ISU Anti-Doping Procedures, as given in the applicable ISU Communications (ISU Communications Nos. 2344 & 2366 or later updates).

## Ice Training

The Organizing Committee will arrange free ice for Official Training on Thursday, October 19 for all participating teams. Extra Official practices will be provided from October 16, 2023. Each training session (50 minutes) will be charged \$20 CAD per skater.

Additional dry training possibilities (i.e. weight room, gym, etc.) is available at the Maurice-Richard arena, basement floor. Free of charge. Reservation is required. Requests must be done by email to Jill Lynch worldcup@speedskating.ca no later than October 1, 2023.

### Liability

In accordance with Rule 119 of the ISU General Regulations, the ISU, Speed Skating Canada, and The Organizing Committee assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection with the ISU World Cup Short Track Speed Skating Competition. Each Member is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.

## **Accommodation**

All teams must make their reservation themselves and should bear their own expenses for accommodations. For accommodations, teams must complete the <u>Accommodation and Travel Form</u> and send it directly to Ms. Yuening Song before **October 1, 2023**.

#### Rooms

The cost of a room (1 to 4 persons per room) is as follows:

Standard (double) Room (per night): \$179.00 + taxes (Lodging 3.5% + TPS 5% + TVQ 9.975%) = \$213.01 CAD Superior (single) Room (per night): \$179.00 + taxes (Lodging 3.5% + TPS 5% + TVQ 9.975%) = \$213.01 CAD Prestige (double) Room (per night): \$189.00 + taxes (Lodging 3.5% + TPS 5% + TVQ 9.975% +) = \$224.91 CAD \*Payment: Cash; in CAD or Credit card; (Visa, Master Card, American Express) or Bank Transfer

#### Meals

Breakfast: \$18.00 + taxes and services (TPS 5% + TVQ 9.975% + Services 15%) = \$23.80 CAD / per person Lunch: \$25.00 + taxes and services (TPS 5% + TVQ 9.975% + Services 15%) = \$33.06 CAD / per person Dinner: \$27.00 + taxes and services (TPS 5% + TVQ 9.975% + Services 15%) = 35.70 CAD / per person

To ensure that enough meals will be prepared, teams must fill the <u>Meals Request Form</u> and send it directly to Mr. Benoit Bilodeau <u>benoit@plazauniversel.com</u> no later than **October 1, 2023.** 

Full payment must be done before or upon arrival to receive meals coupons.

In case of no-shows or cancellation of hotel rooms and meals after **October 10**, **2023**, the ISU Member concerned will be charged 100% of the total costs by the hotel or the Organizing Committee.

### **Transportation**

The Organizing Committee will organize and provide one transportation each way, free of charge, for each team between Montréal – Pierre-Elliot Trudeau International Airport (YUL) and the official hotels, from Sunday, October 15, 2023, to Monday, October 23, 2023.

Expenses for team officials, who do not accompany their team members, are to be borne by themselves \$100.00 CAD.

The Organizing Committee will also provide transportation between the official hotel and Maurice-Richard Arena during the competition days and the training periods, starting from Monday, October 16, 2023.

The date, airline, flight number, expected time of arrival and the date and time of departure should be communicated to the Organizing Committee by completing the <u>Accommodation and Travel Form</u> as soon as possible, but no later than **October 1, 2023.** Please include the amount of special equipment (e.g. bicycles,

massage tables, etc.) that needs to be transported.

#### **Water Bottles**

Plastic water bottles will not be provided by the Organizing Committee. Teams are asked to bring their own reusable water bottles and to use the refill stations at the venue.
