The competitions will be held under the 2022 ISU General Regulations and Special Regulations/Technical Rules for Short Track Speed Skating and ISU Communication No. 2580.

Participation is open to all ISU Members. This competition is part of the ISU World Cup Short Track 2023/24.

#### **Track Conditions**

The Mokdong Ice rink has an artificially refrigerated indoor ice surface of 60 x 30 meters. Protective padding covers the boards in accordance with Rule 280, paragraph 5 and ISU Communication No. 2365 (or any further update). The standard track will be laid out 111.12 meters to the lap.

#### Entries<sup>1</sup>

- a) Entries can only be made using the ISU Online Registration System (ORS) for World Cup Short Track Speed Skating on <a href="https://ors.isu.swisstiming.com/account/login">https://ors.isu.swisstiming.com/account/login</a>.
- b) Entries with the number of Competitors, substitutes, coaches & Team leader and requirements of accommodation must be submitted by **November 13, 2023**.

The number of other personnel travelling with the Team shall be communicated at the same time ISU Members failing to comply in time with these requirements will receive no support from the Organizing Member for:

- Hotel booking;
- Travel arrangements between airport and hotel;
- Travel arrangements between hotel and ice rink;
- Access to Closing Banquet (if held);
- Preferred times for additional training sessions.

All these costs and any additional costs incurred will be for the full account of the ISU Members concerned.

- c) Final Entries must reach the Organizing Committee using the Online Registration System must be submitted at the latest by 20:00 hrs (local time) on **December 5, 2023** (see ISU Communication No. 2580, paragraph 5), and the following information must be communicated to the Organizing Committee:
  - Names of the Competitors and a list of alternate names per category with their International Registration
     Numbers
  - Names of the Competitors and their personal best time, recorded during the period of eligibility, for all individual distances they might participate in
  - Names of the Competitors for each of the respective individual distances;
  - Confirmation of participation in all the competitions of the Relay.

Only the Competitors listed on the Final Entry, respecting the maximum number of entries allowed, can attend and receive an accreditation for the Event.

Final Entries that do not comply with these requirements are considered Post Entries. See Rule 115.

d) Competitors must be present in Seoul at the latest at 18:00 hours on Thursday, December 14, 2023 or the Organizing Committee must receive documented proof that the competitors are in transit and will arrive in due time for the World Cup Competition. Competitors who do not comply with these requirements will be excluded e) Please note that for all persons entered by the Members, the procedures regarding the Declaration for Competitors and Officials (all team Officials requiring an accreditation) entering ISU Events (Rule 131) as

outlined in ISU Communication No. 1628 need to be strictly observed. Declaration Forms must be uploaded in the ORS in each Competitors and Team Officials' profile prior submitting the Entries.

## Citizenships/Residence Requirements and Clearance Procedure

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2526, all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the ISU Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another ISU Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

## **World Cup points**

The points scoring at the World Cup Competition is made in accordance with ISU Communication No. 2580, paragraphs 10, 11 and 12.

## **Anti-Doping**

Anti-Doping tests will be carried out according to the ISU Anti-Doping Rules and ISU Anti-Doping Procedures, as given in the applicable ISU Communications (ISU Communications Nos. 2344 & 2366 or later updates).

# Ice Training

The Organizing Committee will arrange free ice for Official Training on Thursday, December 14 for all participating teams. Extra Official practices will be provided from December 12 to December 13. Each training session (50 min.) will be charged USD\$20/person. Payment for additional practice ice time must be paid in USD\$ to the Organizing Committee on site. Medical coverage will be provided for the official and additional practice sessions in accordance with Rule 140.

#### Liability

In accordance with Rule 119 of the ISU General Regulations, the ISU, Korea Skating Union and The Organizing Committee assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred in connection with the ISU World Cup Short Track Speed Skating Competition. Each Member is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.

#### **Entry Visa Requirements**

Should you need assistance to obtain a Korea entry visa or require a specific letter of invitation, please fill up the information at the visa invitation request form and send it to Organizing Committee by the latest November 17. Each Team is responsible to ensure whether its Team Members need to obtain the KETA authorization to enter Korea.

**Transportation**

**Tickets for Competitors** 

All competitors may apply for 2 tickets per person per day. The number of the tickets are limited, so the principle

tickets can then be collected at the venue by the ticket holder presenting a valid identity card.
