Competition

De Zilveren Bal, "The Silver Ball", is a 100 meter sprint Championship. It is the world's fastest skate show. It is an event where the combination of high level sports and entertainment gives a unique experience to both participants and spectators. Each time three skaters will race against each other over 100 meter. Eventually, after three elimination rounds, the three fastest men and women will go through to the final races. There they will determine who takes the win! Between the races the audience will be entertained in a modern and innovative way. There is never a dull moment! For this event the 11Stedenhal in Leeuwarden will be transformed into a real sports theatre with lights, sound and visual effects.

The race is hosted by the foundation De Zilveren Bal. The board of the foundation is as follows:

The Tournament Director is Jan Ykema, winner of the silver medal in the 500 meter at the 1988 Olympic Games in Calgary.

Regulations

The competition will be held under the ISU rules and conditions included in this announcement.

Liability

In accordance with ISU Rule 119, the Organising Committee assumes no responsibility with respect to medical, bodily or personal injury or property loss or damage sustained or caused in connection with this competition. Each member is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.

Covid-guidelines

The organizing committee will follow the covid-guidelines of the local authorities, KNSB and ISU. Detailed covid-protocol will be described in the information bulletin, which will be published at least two weeks before the event.

Track

A standard indoor speed skating track of 400 meters to the lap laid out at the 11Stedenhal, an artificially frozen indoor skating rink in Leeuwarden, in accordance with ISU Rule 203 and Rule 227.

Participants

There will be 33 male and 33 female participants. Spots are filled as follows:

Y: Skaters within the top 8 of the Sprint League general classification after three races, who already qualified for De Zilveren Bal in category 2.

The Organising Committee has the right to change the number of participants per category for the first round.

Selection criteria & entries

Participants are divided in six categories. All Dutch participants will be invited by the Dutch federation (KNSB). Dutch participants can confirm or decline their invitation on <u>www.inschrijven.schaatsen.nl</u>.

Cat 1. International participants

International participants can enter the competition if they meet the time limits for De Zilveren Bal. Limits for participation for international participants are: 10.30 (male) and 11.20 (female). This can be a 100 meter race, or opening during the 500 meter. The time must be skated during the 2021-2022 season.

International participants can only be registered by the ISU Member who represents them. This can be done by email to <u>info@dezilverenbal.nl</u> with their name, country, age and fastest season 100 meter time. The first 10 registrations per category will be accepted. Unused international spots will be given to Dutch skaters. Entry closes on February 26nd 2022 at 23:59.

Cat 2. Dutch participants group 1

Based on the 100 meter VANTAGE list - Dutch times - (until January 24th 2022) and on the 100 meter opening times of the 500 meter during the National Distance Championship, Olympic Qualification Tournament and National Sprint & Allround Championships. Entry opens on January 24th 2022 at 12:00 and closes on March 11th 2022 at 23:59.

Cat 3. General classification Sprint League

Numbers 1 – 8 of the general classification after three races of the Sprint League. Entry opens on February 27th 2022 at 12:00 and closes on March 11th 2022 at 23:59.

Cat 4. Dutch participants group 2

Selection criteria are equal to category 2, except for the date for the 100 meter VANTAGE list. This is until February 27th 2022. Entry opens on February 27th 2022 at 12:00 and closes on March 11th 2022 at 23:59.

Cat 5. Wild cards

Wild cards are given by the organization.

Cat 6. Reserve

Selection criteria are equal to category 2. Entry opens on February 27th 2022 at 12:00 and closes on March 11th 2022 at 23:59.

Entrance fees

There are no entrance fees for competing in De Zilveren Bal.

Races

Three competitors skate in every race. The warming up lane will also be used as a race lane. There will be four rounds. After each round skaters will be eliminated. Eventually, three skaters will make it to the fourth and final round. The form of this competition is in accordance with ISU Rule 253, paragraph 4.a.

Elimination procedure

After each round some skaters will be eliminated. This goes as follows:

- From round 1 the fastest 21 skaters will make it to round 2.
- From round 2 the fastest 9 skaters will make it to the semi finals.
- From the semi finals the fastest 3 skaters will make it to the final.

Timekeeping

Timekeeping will be done in accordance with ISU Rule 247.

Race information and results

Race information will be posted on <u>www.schaatsen.nl</u> and will also be sent to international participants by email. Results of De Zilveren Bal are in accordance with Rule 265, paragraph 1.a. and will be posted on the website above and also on <u>www.dezilverenbal.nl</u>.

Accreditations

Participants, staff, officials and media each receive an accreditation. This accreditation gives entry to restricted areas. There is one (1) accreditation for a coach available per team. Coaches must apply for their accreditation via email to info@dezilverenbal.nl.

Training times

The Elfstedenhal will be open for training for entered competitors on Monday March 14th and Tuesday March 15th, 2022. Training times will be described in the information bulletin.

Prizes

There is prize money for both men and women. 1^{st} place: $\in 1000, 2^{nd}$ place: $\in 500, 3^{rd}$ place: $\notin 250,-$

The winners also receive a unique silver ball and there can also be extra prizes that would be presented by the event sponsors.

Livestream

The event will be broadcasted live on an online platform.

Medical assistance

Doctors and paramedics will be present on the day of competition. There will be an adequate response time for ambulances to be on site in case of need.

Parking

Parking facilities for competitors and visitors are at the parking area directly next to the 11Stedenhal ice rink. Parking is free.

Transportation

The Organising Committee will arrange transportation for all international participants (not living in the Netherlands) to and from the airport and between the hotel and the ice rink for the competition and other activities.

Hotels

The Organising Committee will arrange accommodation (including meals) for all international participants (not living in the Netherlands) from March 14th until March 17th. This will be at Hotel Van der Valk Wolvega-Heerenveen. Coaches and staff are responsible for their own accommodation and meals. The Organising Committee can recommend the following hotel:
