On behalf of the US Speedskating and the Utah Olympic Oval we have the honour and pleasure to invite you to a Competition in the

ISU WORLD CUP SPEED SKATING 2021/22

which will be held at the Utah Olympic Oval in Salt Lake City, UT on December 3-5, 2021

The Competition will be held under the 2021 ISU General Regulations, Special Regulations and Technical Rules for Speed Skating, ISU Communication No. 2425 and Guidelines for ISU Events During the COVID-19 Pandemic.

This World Cup Competition will serve as one of the qualifying events for quota places at the ISU European Speed Skating Championships 2022, ISU Four Continents Speed Skating Championships 2022, ISU World Speed Skating Championships 2022 (Allround and Sprint combination format and Team Sprint) and the XXIX Olympic Winter Games 2022.

^{*} The actual starting times for the B Division races will be announced during the Online Team leaders' meetings. For each distance, the races of Division A and the races of Division B are considered as two separate competitions with independent final classifications (list of results) for determining the awarding of World Cup points and prize money.

TRACK

In accordance with Rule 203 and 227, a standard speed skating track of 400 meters to the lap laid out at the Utah Olympic Oval, an artificially frozen indoor skating rink in Kearns. The radii of the inner and outer

competition lanes are 26 and 30 meters, respectively. The width of the inside training lane is 4 meters. In accordance with Rue 228, a protective movable padding system will be installed around the track.

ISU COVID-GUIDELINES

All participating team MUST follow the ISU <u>COVID-19-Guidelines</u> for the event. Detailed COVID protocol will be described in Team Leader information.

ENTRIES

Entries for these competitions will be restricted and must be made according to ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2425, paragraph 3.1.

Entries can only be made using the ISU Online Entry System for Speed Skating Events on www.isu.org, section Speed Skating or http://isu.events/login.php and respecting the following deadlines:

Please note that for all persons entered by the ISU Members, the procedures regarding the Declaration for Competitors and Officials (all team officials requiring an accreditation) entering ISU Events (Rule 131) as outlined in ISU Communication No. 1628, need to be strictly observed.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2030, all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the ISU Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another ISU Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

ISU Speed Skating Members not listed in the table above, may enter a maximum of 1 Skater for each distance. All entered Skaters (incl. substitutes) must have achieved applicable qualifying times for the respective distances according to the criteria given in Communication No. 2425, paragraph 3.1.2.

COMPETITION FORMAT AND SAFETY MEASURES FOR THE MASS START EVENTS

Mass Start races will be skated according to Rule 253, paragraph 4 b) in the ISU Technical Rules for Speed Skating and ISU Communication No. 2425, paragraphs 4.3 and 5.6, with distances of 16 laps for both Ladies and Men. Further details, in particular on safety measures, are given in ISU Communication No. 2195 or any further updates.

COMPETITION FORMAT FOR THE TEAM PURSUIT EVENTS

Team Pursuit races will be skated according to Rule 261, paragraph 1 in the ISU Technical Rules for Speed Skating and ISU Communication No. 2425, paragraphs 4.2 and 5.7, with national teams of 3 Skaters each, and with distances of 6 laps for Ladies and 8 laps for Men. Further details, in particular on safety measures, are given in ISU Communication No. 2195 or any further updates.

GROUPING AND DRAWING PROCEDURES

The grouping and drawing of pairs will be made according to ISU Communication No. 2425, paragraph 5.

PRIZES AND POINTS

For each event, World Cup points and prize money will be awarded according to ISU Communication No. 2425, paragraphs 6 and 7.2 accordingly.

ANTI-DOPING

Anti-Doping tests will be carried out according to the ISU Anti-Doping Rules and ISU Anti-Doping Procedures, as given in the applicable ISU Communications Nos. 2344 and 2366 (or any further update of these Communications).

TRAINING TIMES

The speed skating track will be open for training for entered competitors from Tuesday, November 30, 2021. Trial starts will be organized on Thursday, December 2, 2021 during the official morning practice.

Only accredited competitors, substitutes and team officials will be allowed to enter the ice-rink during the official training hours.

Additional training times to ice and running track before Tuesday, November 30th will be available at a charge of \$20 for a Day-Use Pass (this includes usage of ice and/or running track). Team Leaders are requested to provide daily participant numbers in the morning at Guest Services and pay provided invoice no later than before start of Team Leaders Meeting on December 2, 2021 at Guest Services.

FACE MASKS

No advertising marking is allowed on face masks. Face masks may display one (1) manufacturer trademark/identification of maximum 8cm². In addition, ISU Member's name and/or abbreviation and/or national flag and/or Skater's name may be displayed on the face mask.

TRANSPORTATION

Airport: Salt Lake City International Airport (SLC)
Major airlines flying into SLC: Delta, United, American Airlines, Southwest
The airport is located about 12 miles (20km) from the hotel(s).

The OC will **NOT** provide any means of organized transportation. Teams will be provided with a Transportation Stipend, to be paid in cash in US\$ upon teams check-in at the Race Office.

Teams will be provided with a stipend in the following amount:

Teams 5 or less competing athletes: US\$300 Teams 6 or more competing athletes: US\$600

Teams are responsible to book and secure their own preferred method of transportation by making arrangements with a car rental company of their choice. The OC will NOT provide ANY bus transportation between airport and hotel AND hotel and venue at any time.

The hotel does not have shuttle service available.

The OC recommends to make your own transportation arrangements early on to secure desired vehicles.

VISA REQUIREMENTS & COVID-19 PANDEMIC ACCESS RESTRICTIONS (as of 10/25/2021)

A visitor visa may be required for participants and team officials. Please contact the US Speedskating if you need an invitation letter for the visa. For the invitation letter please submit the following information:

VISA REQUIREMENTS

Please check well before your departure on what your countries specific **visa requirements** will be to enter the United States. Check the website of the US Embassy in the country you plan to apply for a US visa and

check on processing time frames for non-immigrant visas. Currently some countries experience significantly extended visa processing times at US Embassies due to staff shortage and/or backlog from the past year and/or other reasons.

The OC is happy to provide each country which requires visas for their participants a Letter of Invitation for a LONG-LIST of your athletes and staff to ensure you can start the visa application process as soon as possible.

ENTRY PROTOCOL TO THE UNITED STATES

FULLY VACCINATED PARTICIPANTS:

Fully vaccinated is defined as one dosage of J&J or two dosages of any other vaccines approved by WHO or FDA (U.S. Food & Drug Administration). Last dosage must have been administered at least 14 days prior to travel.

- ALL fully vaccinated participants must carry proof of full vaccination with them at time of entry.
- ALL fully vaccinated participants must provide proof of a pre-departure negative PCR test taken within 72h of departure.
- ALL fully vaccinated participants must take precautions during air travel to protect against the further introduction, transmission, and spread of COVID-19 by wearing a face mask.

NON VACCINATED PARTICIPANTS & NOT FULLY VACCINATED PARTICIPANTS:

Non vaccinated or not fully vaccinated is defined as following:

- a) Non vaccination due to medical reasons/exemption
- b) Previous COVID-19 infection within the last 90 days before travel
- c) Vaccination by vaccine that is not approved by WHO or FDA
- ALL non-vaccinated or not fully vaccinated participants must provide proof of a pre-departure negative PCR test taken within 24h of departure.
- ALL non-vaccinated or not fully vaccinated participants must take precautions during air travel to protect against the further introduction, transmission, and spread of COVID-19 by wearing a face mask.
- ALL non-vaccinated or not fully vaccinated participants must carry a personal NIE (National Interest Exemption) letter issued to them

The OC is encouraging all participants to get fully vaccinated at least 14 days prior traveling to the US. This will immensely simplify your travel. Other participants must submit the NIE waiver form to the Organizing Committee as soon as possible.
