The Competition will be held under the 2022 ISU General Regulations, Special Regulations and Technical Rules for Speed Skating, ISU Communication No. 2505 and Guidelines for ISU Events During the COVID-19 Pandemic.

This World Cup Competition will serve as one of the qualifying events for quota places at the ISU European Speed Skating Championships 2023, ISU Four Continents Speed Skating Championships 2023, and ISU World Speed Skating Championships 2023

For each distance, the races of Division A and the races of Division B are considered as two separate competitions with independent final classifications (list of results) for determining the awarding of World Cup points and prize money.

### **TRACK**

A standard speed skating track of 400 meters to the lap laid out at Vår Energi Arena Sørmarka, an artificially frozen indoor skating rink in Stavanger. The radii of the inner and outer competition lanes are 26 and 30 meters, respectively. The width of the inside warm-up lane is 4 meters.

### **ENTRIES**

Entries for these competitions will be restricted and must be made according to ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 2505, paragraph 3.1.

ISU Speed Skating Members not listed in the table above, may enter a maximum of 1 Skater for each distance. All entered Skaters (incl. substitutes) must have achieved applicable qualifying times for the respective distances according to the criteria given in Communication No. 2505, paragraph 3.1.2.

### COMPETITION FORMAT AND SAFETY MEASURES FOR THE MASS START EVENTS

Mass Start races will be skated according to Rule 253, paragraph 4 b) in the ISU Technical Rules for Speed Skating and ISU Communication No. 2505, paragraphs 4.3 and 5.6, with distances of 16 laps for both Ladies and Men. Further details, in particular on safety measures, are given in ISU Communication No. 2477 or any further updates.

#### COMPETITION FORMAT FOR THE TEAM PURSUIT EVENTS

Team Pursuit races will be skated according to Rule 261, paragraph 1 in the ISU Technical Rules for Speed Skating and ISU Communication No. 2505, paragraphs 4.2 and 5.7, with national teams of 3 Skaters each, and with distances of 6 laps for Ladies and 8 laps for Men. Further details, in particular on safety measures, are given in ISU Communication No. 2477 or any further updates.

### **GROUPING AND DRAWING PROCEDURES**

The grouping and drawing of pairs will be made according to ISU Communication No. 2505, paragraph 5.

#### **PRIZES AND POINTS**

For each event, World Cup points and prize money will be awarded according to ISU Communication No. 2505, paragraphs 6 and 7.2 accordingly.

#### **ANTI-DOPING**

Anti-Doping tests will be carried out according to the ISU Anti-Doping Rules and ISU Anti-Doping Procedures, as given in the applicable ISU Communications Nos. 2344 and 2366 (or any further update of these Communications).

### **TRAINING TIMES**

The speed skating track will be open for training for entered Competitors from November 07. Trial starts will be organized on November 09 according to the training schedule.

Only accredited Competitors, substitutes and team officials will be allowed to enter the ice-rink during the official training hours.

ISU Members may ask for changes in the training schedule latest by *October 28, 2022*. Decisions on changes' request will be taken by the Organizing Committee in consultation with the ISU.

#### LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119 of the ISU General Regulations, the ISU, the Norwegian Skating Association and the Organizing Committee assume no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property loss or damage incurred in connection with the ISU World Cup Speed Skating. Each ISU Member is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.

#### **FACE MASKS**

No advertising marking is allowed on face masks. Face masks may display one (1) manufacturer trademark/identification of maximum 8cm². In addition, ISU Member's name and/or abbreviation and/or national flag and/or Skater's name may be displayed on the face mask.

# **ACCOMMODATION**

Participating ISU Members will have to bear expenses for accommodation for all participating Skaters and team officials.

The cost of a room and meal at the official hotel(s) will be as follows (including all taxes):

Single Room occupancy: 1690,- NOK (approx. 170 EURO) per room per night. Price including meals and drinks.

Double Room occupancy; 2490,- NOK (approx. 250 EURO) per room per night. Price including meals and drinks.

Cancellation policy:

Before Sept. 20; 50% of rooms can be cancelled with no cost

From Sept 20.- Oct. 5: 10% of rooms can be cancelled with no cost

After Oct. 5.: No refund after this date

Payment: invoice will be sent in advance.

Teams have to pay the invoice before October 26. No check-in without payment.

Accommodation requests can only be made directly with the Organizing Committee.

### **TRANSPORTATION**

Stavanger International Airport connects with several direct flights daily to Amsterdam, Copenhagen and London Heathrow airports. Between Stavanger and Oslo International Airport Gardermoen there are flight connections almost every hour.

There are public bus connections (travel time appr. 20 minutes) from and to the Stavanger International Airport for transportation to the hotel, every 30 minutes (Price 149 NOK per person from Stavanger Airport to Madlakrossen), see information at <a href="https://flybussen.no/en/trip">https://flybussen.no/en/trip</a>. There is app. 5 min walk from the bus stop "Madlakrossen" to the official hotel.

Taxi transfer is available at a cost of NOK 500 – 700 one way.
