## Announcement / Invitation

## 1. General

The Bavarian Open Competition is conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2016, the Special Regulations \& Technical Rules Single \& Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2016, and the relevant ISU Communications.

The Bavarian Open Competition is open to all competitors who belong to an ISU Member and qualify with regard to eligibility according to Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 1420 or any update of this Communication, as well as this Announcement.

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU General Regulations and ISU Communication 1420 all Skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate. Passports of all Skaters as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

The final composition of the panels will be done after the Entry deadline and will be published to the participating Member in time. The organizer will cover accommodation for accepted Judges and invited Officials. Meals for accepted Judges and invited Officials are provided at the ice-rink during the days of competition.

Time-Schedule: The competition starts on February 14, 2017 in the evening or on February 15, 2017 in the morning, due to the number of entries of Advanced Novices and will be finished on Sunday, February 19, 2016.
