Decision of ISU Disciplinary Commission

On January 12, 2017, the ISU Technical Committee Single & Pair Skating, represented by ISU Legal Advisor, Prof. Dr. Michael Geistlinger, filed a complaint against the Alleged Offender Ms Laimute Krauziene, a member of the Lithuanian Skating Federation and Figure Skating Official, for a violation of the duties of judges and of the Code of Ethics.

Following consideration of the alleged violation of the ISU Code of Ethics and of the Duties of Officials, the ISU Disciplinary Commission has, on March 11, 2017 taken the following decision:

“Decision

- 1. Ms. Laimute Krauziene has violated the duties of a judge and the ISU Code of Ethics.*
- 2. Ms. Laimute Krauziene is reprimanded and warned to not engage in similar conduct in the future, which conduct will cause a more severe action.*
- 3. All parties shall bear their own costs.*

The decision of the Disciplinary Commission is published in full on the ISU website.

This decision is subject to appeal to the Court of Arbitration for Sport (CAS), in accordance with Article 25 Paragraph 12 and Article 26 of the ISU Constitution 2016.
