#### **Decisions of the ISU Council**

The ISU Council met between March 30 and April 2, 2012 in Nice, France. The following were among the decisions taken by the Council during the meeting:

#### 1. ISU Championships/ISU Events – change/determination of dates or site

- a) ISU Four Continents Figure Skating Championships 2013 change of dates: The ISU Council agreed to a proposal from the organizing Member, the Japan Skating Federation, to modify the dates of the ISU Four Continents Figure Skating Championships 2013 to be held in Osaka, Japan on February 6-11, 2013 (instead of February 5-10) taking into account that the last day of the Championships on Monday, February 11, 2013 will be a public holiday in Japan.
- b) ISU World Short Track Speed Skating Championships 2013 change of site: The Council accepted a request from the Hungarian National Skating Federation to hold the ISU World Short Track Speed Skating Championships 2013 in Debrecen (instead of Budapest).
- c) ISU World Team Trophy in Figure Skating 2013 dates: The ISU Council decided to hold the ISU World Team Trophy in Japan, on April 11-14, 2013.

### **4. ISU Development Trophy**

The Council decided to launch the ISU Development Trophy with a first edition to be held during the season 2012/13. This competition will be restricted to Skaters of developing ISU Members of both the Figure Skating and Speed Skating Branch. All relevant details are being worked out by the ISU Development Coordinator in cooperation with the relevant ISU internal bodies and full details will be announced in due time.

### **5. ISU Council meeting**

The Council agreed to meet again on June 10 and 16-17, 2012 in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia.
