<sup>\*)</sup> Following a Substantial Assistance Request, WADA has reviewed the information provided by CHINADA and has accepted, in agreement with the International Skating Union ("ISU"), to suspend Mr. Li's remaining period of ineligibility, which is approximately 1 year 10 months and 14 days.

Consequently, Mr. Li may return to competition as of 29 March 2019.

The ISU reminds all ISU Members that as a matter of principle Ineligible Skaters may not participate in any capacity in any activity of the ISU, the ISU's Members, their members and/or other organizers.

For all details regarding Ineligibility including return to training and to competition at the end of the Period of Ineligibility, please, refer to Articles 10.12 and 10.13 of the ISU Anti-Doping Rules (ISU Communication 2213 or any later update).

Skaters, other persons and ISU Members violating the rules concerning Ineligibility are subject to additional sanctions.
