ISU Skating Awards will be back in 2023

The International Skating Union (ISU), together with its partner Art on Ice, will present the third edition of the ISU Skating Awards in 2023 by way of an exciting show featuring spectacular performances, exclusive musical entertainment, as well as a unique ceremony.

After two ISU Skating Awards editions live-streamed in 2020 and 2021, the ISU and Art on Ice have again joined their vision and expertise to create a promising new show to be unveiled in the course of 2023. Orchestrated and presented by star-guests, the third edition will honor the performances and careers of outstanding Figure Skaters and the work of inspiring Coaches and Choreographers.

Considering the multiple challenges faced during the 2021/22 season, including but not limited to the war in Ukraine and its consequences on ISU activities, the Council tried its best to find solutions but ultimately concluded that, regrettably, the ISU Skating Awards 2022 will be postponed and held in 2023 - simultaneously with the ISU Skating Awards Season 2023 (Refer to [Communication 2466](#) for the full report).

Given the importance of this event for the celebration of Figure Skating and all the passion attached to this special project, the ISU and its partner Art on Ice are more than ever committed in presenting an exceptional 2023 edition bringing together exclusive artistic, musical and skating performances.
